## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to school buses and other vehicles used to
- 2 transport pupils.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

### H.F. 2109

- 1 Section 1. Section 321.1, subsection 69, paragraph d, Code 2 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 d. New or used motor vehicles designed to carry not more
- 4 than ten twelve persons as passengers, including the driver,
- 5 or used passenger vans designed to carry not more than twelve
- 6 persons as passengers, including the driver, either school
- 7 owned or privately owned, which are used to transport pupils
- 8 to activity events in which the pupils are participants or
- 9 used to transport pupils to their homes in case of illness or
- 10 other emergency situations. The vehicles operated under the
- 11 provisions of this paragraph shall be operated by employees of
- 12 the school district who are specifically approved by the local
- 13 superintendent of schools for the assignment.
- 14 Sec. 2. Section 321.373, subsection 2, Code 2024, is amended
- 15 to read as follows:
- 16 2. Rules prescribed for school buses shall provide
- 17 standards for structural strength, materials, and insulation
- 18 of the school bus body; color; seat and aisle arrangement;
- 19 dimension and construction of service door; control of the
- 20 front door or doors; emergency door and its location and
- 21 construction; windows; roof ventilators; heaters; location,
- 22 filling, and draining of the fuel tank; bumpers and how they
- 23 shall be attached to the bus; lettering and identification
- 24 of the bus; stop signal arm; and warning lights and flashing
- 25 lights; and shall authorize the use of vehicles modified or
- 26 manufactured to accommodate wheelchair access with or without
- 27 the use of a ramp.
- 28 Sec. 3. Section 321.373, subsection 3, paragraphs a and c,
- 29 Code 2024, are amended to read as follows:
- 30 a. The rules prescribed for school buses shall include
- 31 special rules for passenger automobiles, and other vehicles
- 32 designed to carry ten twelve or fewer persons, including the
- 33 driver, when used as school buses.
- c. The rules shall allow new or used passenger vans designed
- 35 to carry twelve or fewer passengers, including the driver, and

- 1 weighing ten thousand pounds or less, to be used as school
  2 buses if the van does not carry more passengers than there are
- 3 safety belts or safety harnesses in the van as installed by
- 4 the manufacturer. The operator of the van shall comply with
- 5 the qualification, licensing, and instruction requirements set
- 6 forth in sections 321.375 and 321.376.
- 7 EXPLANATION
- 8 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 9 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 10 Under current law, every vehicle operated for the
- 11 transportation of children to or from school is considered
- 12 a school bus, with limited exceptions including new or used
- 13 motor vehicles designed to carry not more than 10 persons
- 14 as passengers, including the driver, or used passenger vans
- 15 designed to carry not more than 12 persons as passengers,
- 16 including the driver, which are used to transport pupils to
- 17 activity events or in emergency situations if the vehicle is
- 18 operated by an approved employee of the school district.
- 19 This bill instead excludes from the definition of "school
- 20 bus" all new or used motor vehicles designed to carry not more
- 21 than 12 persons as passengers, including the driver, which
- 22 are used to transport pupils to activity events in which the
- 23 pupils are participants, or used to transport pupils to their
- 24 homes in case of illness or other emergency situations. The
- 25 bill makes corresponding changes to related provisions in Code
- 26 section 321.373. In accordance with current law, the vehicles
- 27 must be operated by employees of the school district who are
- 28 specifically approved by the local superintendent of schools
- 29 for the assignment.
- 30 Current department of education (DE) administrative rules
- 31 prohibit the use of ramps on a vehicle operated as a school
- 32 bus, except when used on the MV-1 purpose-built wheelchair
- 33 accessible vehicle (281 IAC 44.4(2)(g)).
- The bill requires DE rules to authorize the use of vehicles
- 35 modified or manufactured to accommodate wheelchair access with

1 or without the use of a ramp.
