## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the regulation of confinement feeding
- 2 operations, including by providing for partially roofed
- 3 structures and prohibiting the construction, including
- 4 expansion, of structures, making penalties applicable, and
- 5 including effective date provisions.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 459.102, subsection 15, Code 2024, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 15. "Confinement feeding operation" means an animal feeding
- 4 operation in which animals are confined to areas which are
- 5 totally or partially roofed.
- 6 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 459.104 Moratorium confinement
- 7 feeding operation structures.
- 8 l. Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter or any
- 9 other provision of law to the contrary, a person shall not
- 10 construct, including expand, a confinement feeding operation
- 11 structure.
- 12 2. Subsection 1 does not apply to a confinement feeding
- 13 operation structure that is part of a small animal feeding
- 14 operation.
- 15 3. This section does not prohibit a person from completing
- 16 construction, including expansion, of a confinement feeding
- 17 operation structure if, prior to the effective date of this
- 18 Act, the person has begun construction, including expansion,
- 19 of the confinement feeding operation structure as otherwise
- 20 allowed under this chapter.
- 21 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 22 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 23 EXPLANATION
- 24 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 25 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 26 GENERAL. This bill amends Code chapter 459 (the "Animal
- 27 Agriculture Compliance Act") (Code section 459.101) which
- 28 regulates confinement feeding operations. The bill revises
- 29 the definition of a confinement feeding operation to include
- 30 an operation that is partially roofed (amended Code section
- 31 459.102(15)). An open feed lot is an animal feeding operation
- 32 that may be partially roofed (Code section 459A.102). The
- 33 bill also prohibits the construction, including expansion, of
- 34 a confinement feeding operation structure. Such a structure
- 35 includes a confinement building, a manure storage structure,

- 1 or an egg washwater structure. The bill provides an exception 2 that allows construction if the new structure is part of a 3 small animal feeding operation. The bill does not prohibit a 4 person from completing construction if the person had begun 5 construction prior to the effective date of the bill. BACKGROUND - ENFORCEMENT AND APPLICABLE CIVIL PENALTIES. 7 Compliance with a statutory regulation under Code chapter 459 8 includes compliance with a rule adopted by the department of 9 natural resources (Code section 459.103). A person violating 10 air quality regulations under Code chapter 459, subchapter 11 II, is subject to an administrative assessment of a civil 12 penalty of up to \$10,000 (Code sections 459.602 and 455B.109). 13 A person violating a water quality regulation under Code 14 chapter 459, subchapter III, is subject to the administrative 15 assessment of a civil penalty of up to \$10,000 (Code sections 16 459.603 and 455B.109) or a judicially assessed civil penalty of
