## A BILL FOR

Section 1. NEW SECTION. 321.491A Driver improvement information.

The department shall include in the electronic database used by the department and law enforcement to access registration, titling, and driver's license information, details indicating whether a driver has been required by the department or ordered by a court to complete remedial driver improvement action, including any driver improvement education course, following an arrest, citation, conviction, or accident, and if so, whether the driver completed the action.

EXPLANATION

> The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

This bill requires the department of transportation (DOT) to include in the electronic database used by the DOT and law enforcement to access registration, titling, and driver's license information, details indicating whether a driver has been required to take or has completed remedial driver improvement action, including a driver improvement education course.

Under current law and administrative rules adopted by the DOT, the DOT must require remedial driver improvement action when a person holding an instruction permit, intermediate license, or full-privilege driver's license under Code section 321.180 B is convicted of a moving violation or has a contributive accident, and the violation or accident occurred during the term of the instruction permit or intermediate license. In addition, the DOT may require a driver to complete a driver improvement program in lieu of driver's license suspension under certain circumstances.
