- 1 Section 1. Section 80B.11, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code 2 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 a. Minimum entrance requirements, course of study,
- 4 attendance requirements, and equipment and facilities required
- 5 at approved law enforcement training schools.
- 6 (1) Minimum entrance requirements for entrance to approved
- 7 law enforcement training schools shall include that any law
- 8 enforcement officer be a citizen of the United States.
- 9 (2) Minimum age requirements for entrance to approved law
- 10 enforcement training schools shall be eighteen years of age.
- 11 (3) Minimum course of study requirements shall include a
- 12 separate domestic abuse curriculum, which may include but is
- 13 not limited to outside speakers from domestic abuse shelters
- 14 and crime victim assistance organizations. Minimum course
- 15 of study requirements shall also include a sexual assault
- 16 curriculum.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
