A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to temporary unemployment for purposes of
- 2 eligibility for unemployment compensation benefits.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 96.1A, subsection 37, paragraph c, Code 2 2023, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 c. An individual shall be deemed "temporarily unemployed"
- 4 if for a period, verified by the department, not to exceed
- 5 four consecutive weeks, the individual is unemployed due
- 6 to a plant shutdown, vacation, inventory, lack of work, or
- 7 emergency from the individual's regular job or trade in which
- 8 the individual worked full-time and will again work full-time,
- 9 if the individual's employment, although temporarily suspended,
- 10 has not been terminated.
- 11 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 14 This bill strikes a requirement that a period of temporary
- 15 unemployment, for purposes of eligibility for unemployment
- 16 benefits, cannot exceed four weeks. An individual who is
- 17 temporarily unemployed is exempt from registering for work at
- 18 an employment office and from being able to work, available for
- 19 work, and earnestly and actively seeking work in order to be
- 20 eligible for unemployment benefits.
