- 3 enrolled in grades ten through twelve.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **279.77** Requirement to inform 2 students Iowa tuition grant.
- Each school district shall, in consultation with the college 4 student aid commission, develop and disseminate information and 5 educational materials related to the Iowa tuition grant program 6 established pursuant to chapter 261, subchapter II, part 1, to
- 8 EXPLANATION

7 students enrolled in grades ten through twelve.

- 9 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 10 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- Current law establishes the Iowa tuition grant program
 within the college student aid commission. Under the program,
 the commission awards grants to Iowa residents enrolled at one
 of Iowa's eligible private colleges or universities. This bill
 requires school districts, in consultation with the commission,
 to develop and disseminate information and educational
 materials related to the program to students enrolled in grades
 through 12.
