- 1 Section 1. Section 331.752, subsection 5, Code 2024, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 5. The resolution changing the status of a county attorney
- 4 shall state the initial annual salary to be paid to the county
- 5 attorney when the full-time or part-time status is effective.
- 6 The annual salary specified in the resolution shall remain
- 7 effective until changed as provided in section 331.907. Except
- 8 in counties having a population of more than two hundred
- 9 thousand, the annual salary of a full-time county attorney
- 10 shall be an amount which is between forty-five percent and one
- 11 hundred percent of the annual salary received by a district
- 12 court judge.
- 13 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 16 This bill relates to the salary of county attorneys
- 17 in certain counties. Current law requires counties with
- 18 populations of 200,000 or less to pay county attorneys a salary
- 19 between 45 and 100 percent of a district court judge's salary.
- 20 The bill strikes this requirement.
