- 2 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 d. A conviction under section 321J.2, except for a
- 4 conviction under section 321J.2, subsection 2, paragraph "a",
- 5 involving a defendant who was twenty-five years of age or
- 6 younger at the time of the offense, and if the offense did not
- 7 involve a serious injury, as defined in section 702.18, to any
- 8 person other than to the defendant.
- 9 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 12 This bill relates to the expungement of an
- 13 operating-while-intoxicated (OWI) offense that is a serious
- 14 misdemeanor under certain circumstances.
- 15 Current law does not allow the expungement of a conviction
- 16 under Code section 321J.2. The bill provides that a conviction
- 17 under Code section 321J.2 that is a serious misdemeanor shall
- 18 not be expunged except for a conviction involving a defendant
- 19 who was 25 years of age or younger at the time of the offense,
- 20 and the offense did not involve a serious injury, as defined in
- 21 Code section 702.18, to any person other than to the defendant.
