- 1 Section 1. Section 272C.2, subsection 2, Code 2024, is
- 2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:
- 3 NEW PARAGRAPH. h. Not require a licensee to obtain
- 4 continuing education credits in a subject matter that is not
- 5 directly related to the practice of the licensee's occupation
- 6 or profession.
- 7 Sec. 2. Section 272C.3, Code 2024, is amended by adding the
- 8 following new subsection:
- 9 NEW SUBSECTION. 5. Notwithstanding any provision of law
- 10 to the contrary, a board shall not require an applicant for a
- 11 license to obtain education credits in a subject matter that
- 12 is not directly related to the practice of the occupation or
- 13 profession for which the applicant seeks a license.
- Sec. 3. Section 602.1206, Code 2024, is amended by adding
- 15 the following new subsection:
- 16 NEW SUBSECTION. 3. The supreme court shall not require an
- 17 attorney to receive education credits in a subject matter that
- 18 is not directly related to the practice of law as a condition
- 19 of receiving or renewing a license to practice law.
- 20 EXPLANATION
- 21 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 22 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 23 This bill relates to the issuance and renewal of
- 24 professional and occupational licenses. The bill prohibits
- 25 a licensing board, including the supreme court in licensing
- 26 attorneys, from requiring an applicant or licensee to obtain
- 27 education credits in a subject matter that is not directly
- 28 related to the practice of the profession as a condition of
- 29 receiving or renewing a professional or occupational license.
