- 1 An Act relating to the transportation to and from school of

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 282.18, subsection 8, paragraph b, Code 2 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 b. (1) A receiving district with a total enrollment of
- 4 less than two thousand students may send school vehicles not
- 5 more than two miles into the district of residence of the
- 6 pupil using the open enrollment option under this section,
- 7 for the purpose of transporting the pupil to and from school
- 8 in the receiving district, if the boards of both the sending
- 9 and receiving districts agree to this arrangement pupil's
- 10 primary residence is closer to the attendance center the pupil
- 11 attends in the receiving district than the residence is to the
- 12 attendance center the pupil would be assigned in the sending
- 13 district.
- 14 (2) Notwithstanding subparagraph (1), a receiving district
- 15 with a total enrollment of greater than or equal to two
- 16 thousand students may send school vehicles two miles or more
- 17 into the district of residence of the pupil using the open
- 18 enrollment option under this section, for the purpose of
- 19 transporting the pupil to and from school in the receiving
- 20 district, regardless of the distance between the pupil's
- 21 primary residence and the attendance center the pupil attends
- 22 in the receiving district or the attendance center the pupil
- 23 would be assigned in the sending district, if all of the
- 24 following apply:
- 25 (a) The total enrollment of the pupil's district of
- 26 residence is less than two thousand students.
- 27 (b) The pupil's district of residence is contiquous to the
- 28 receiving district.
- 29 (c) The pupil's district of residence has sent school
- 30 vehicles into the receiving district pursuant to subparagraph
- 31 (1).
- 32 EXPLANATION
- 33 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 34 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 35 This bill relates to the transportation to and from school

1 of pupils participating in open enrollment. Current law
 2 authorizes a receiving school district to send school vehicles
 3 into the district of residence of a pupil who open enrolls,
 4 for the purpose of transporting the pupil to and from school
 5 in the receiving school district, if the boards of directors
 6 of the sending school district and receiving school district
 7 agree to this arrangement. The bill strikes the requirement
 8 that the boards of directors of the sending school district and
 9 receiving school district agree to the arrangement.
      The bill provides that a receiving district with a total
10
11 enrollment of less than 2,000 students may send school vehicles
12 not more than two miles into the district of residence of the
13 pupil who open enrolls, for the purpose of transporting the
14 pupil to and from school in the receiving district, if the
15 pupil's primary residence is closer to the attendance center
16 the pupil attends in the receiving district than the residence
17 is to the attendance center the pupil would be assigned in the
18 sending district. The bill also provides that a receiving
19 district with a total enrollment of at least 2,000 students
20 may send school vehicles two miles or more into the district
21 of residence of the pupil who open enrolls, regardless of
22 the distance between the pupil's primary residence and the
23 attendance center the pupil attends in the receiving district
24 or the attendance center the pupil would be assigned in the
25 sending district, if the total enrollment of the pupil's
26 district of residence is less than two thousand students, the
27 pupil's district of residence is contiquous to the receiving
28 district, and the pupil's district of residence has sent school
29 vehicles into the receiving district.
