- 1 An Act increasing the state minimum hourly wage.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 91D.1, subsection 1, paragraphs a and d, 2 Code 2024, are amended to read as follows:
- 3 a. The state hourly wage shall be at least \$6.20 as of April
- 4 1, 2007, and \$7.25 as of January 1, 2008 \$10.85 as of July 1,
- 5 2024, \$13.00 as of July 1, 2025, and \$15.00 as of July 1, 2026.
- 6 d. An employer is not required to pay an employee the
- 7 applicable state hourly wage provided in paragraph ``a" until the
- 8 employee has completed ninety calendar days of employment with
- 9 the employer. An employer shall pay an employee who has not
- 10 completed ninety calendar days of employment with the employer
- 11 an hourly wage of at least \$5.30 as of April 1, 2007, and \$6.35
- 12 as of January 1, 2008 \$9.95 as of July 1, 2024, \$12.10 as of
- 13 July 1, 2025, and \$14.10 as of July 1, 2026.
- 14 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 17 This bill increases the state minimum hourly wage to \$10.85
- 18 as of July 1, 2024, \$13.00 as of July 1, 2025, and \$15.00 as of
- 19 July 1, 2026. The bill increases the state minimum hourly wage
- 20 for employees employed for less than 90 days to \$9.95 as of
- 21 July 1, 2024, \$12.10 as of July 1, 2025, and \$14.10 as of July
- 22 1, 2026.
