- 2 2024, is amended by striking the paragraph and inserting in

- 6 takes place during a period beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the
- 7 first day of August and ending at midnight on the fourteenth

- 9 (1) An article of clothing.
- 10 (2) School supplies including school art supplies.
- 11 (3) School computer supplies.
- 12 (4) School instructional materials.
- 13 (5) Musical instruments.
- 14 (6) Sport or recreational equipment.
- 15 Sec. 2. Section 423.3, subsection 68, paragraph b,
- 16 subparagraph (1), Code 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 (1) Sport or recreational equipment and protective

- 19 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 22 This bill modifies the sales tax holiday. The bill makes
- 23 new items eligible for the sales tax holiday including school
- 24 supplies, school art supplies, school computer supplies, school
- 25 instructional materials, musical instruments, and sports or
- 26 recreational equipment. The bill increases the eligible
- 27 purchase amount of an item during the sales tax holiday from
- 28 \$100 to \$250. The bill expands the sales tax holiday from a
- 29 two-day period beginning on the first Friday of August to a
- 30 14-day period beginning on August 1 and ending on August 14.
