## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to bestiality and providing penalties.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 717C.1, subsection 1, paragraph b, Code 2 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 b. "Sex act" means any sexual contact between a person and
- 4 an animal by penetration of the penis into the vagina or anus,
- 5 contact between the mouth and genitalia, or by contact between
- 6 the genitalia of one and the genitalia or anus of the other. of
- 7 the following conduct that is not the practice of veterinary
- 8 medicine under section 169.3, subsection 13, an accepted animal
- 9 husbandry livestock management practice under section 169.3,
- 10 subsection 1, an accepted practice related to the insemination
- 11 of animals for the purpose of procreation, or an accepted
- 12 practice related to conformation judging:
- 13 (1) An act between a person and an animal involving physical
- 14 contact between the sex organ, genitals, or anus of one and the
- 15 mouth, sex organ, genitals, or anus of the other.
- 16 (2) Any touching or fondling by a person, either directly
- 17 or through clothing, of the sex organ, genitals, or anus of
- 18 an animal or any insertion, however slight, of any part of a
- 19 person's body or any object into the vaginal or anal opening of
- 20 an animal except for veterinarian advised care of the animal.
- 21 (3) Any insertion, however slight, of any part of an
- 22 animal's body into the vaginal or anal opening of a person.
- 23 (4) Advertising, offering, selling, transferring,
- 24 purchasing, or otherwise obtaining an animal with the intent
- 25 that the animal be used for sexual contact in this state.
- 26 (5) Organizing, promoting, conducting, or participating
- 27 as an observer of an act involving conduct described in
- 28 subparagraph (1), (2), or (3).
- 29 (6) Knowingly permits conduct described in subparagraph
- 30 (1), (2), or (3) to occur in any premises under the person's
- 31 ownership or control.
- (7) Photographing or filming obscene material, as defined
- 33 in section 728.1, depicting a person engaging in conduct
- 34 described in subparagraph (1), (2), or (3).
- 35 (8) Distributing, selling, publishing, or transmitting

- 4 (9) Possessing with the intent to distribute, sell,
- 5 publish, or transmit obscene material, as defined in section

- 8 (10) Forcing, coercing, enticing, or encouraging a minor to
- 9 engage in conduct described in subparagraph (1), (2), or (3).
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 717C.1, subsection 2, Code 2024, is amended
- 11 to read as follows:
- 12 2. a. A person who performs a sex act with an animal is
- 13 guilty of an aggravated misdemeanor.
- 14 b. A person who commits a second or subsequent violation of
- 15 this section is guilty of a class "D" felony.
- 16 c. A person previously convicted of a violation of section
- 17 717B.2, 717B.3, 717B.3A, or 717B.3B who commits a violation of
- 18 this section is quilty of a class "D" felony.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 22 This bill relates to bestiality.
- 23 Under current law, a person who performs a sex act with an
- 24 animal is guilty of an aggravated misdemeanor. Current law
- 25 defines "sex act" as any sexual contact between a person and
- 26 an animal by penetration of the penis into the vagina or anus,
- 27 contact between the mouth and genitalia, or by contact between
- 28 the genitalia of one and the genitalia or anus of the other.
- 29 The bill provides that a "sex act" includes the following
- 30 conduct that is not the practice of veterinary medicine, an
- 31 accepted animal husbandry livestock management practice, an
- 32 accepted practice related to the insemination of animals for
- 33 the purpose of procreation, or an accepted practice related to
- 34 conformation judging: an act between a person and an animal
- 35 involving physical contact between the sex organ, genitals, or

 2 other; any touching or fondling by a person, either directly
 3 or through clothing, of the sex organ, genitals, or anus of
 4 an animal or any insertion, however slight, of any part of a

 6 an animal except for veterinarian advised care of the animal;
 7 any insertion, however slight, of any part of an animal's body
8 into the vaginal or anal opening of a person; advertising,
 9 offering, selling, transferring, purchasing, or otherwise
10 obtaining an animal with the intent that the animal be used
11 for sexual contact in this state; organizing, promoting,
12 conducting, or participating as an observer of an act involving
13 a sex act with an animal; knowingly permitting a sex act with
14 an animal to occur in any premises under the person's ownership
15 or control; photographing or filming obscene material depicting
16 a person engaging in a sex act with an animal; distributing,
17 selling, publishing, or transmitting obscene material depicting
18 a person engaged in a sex act with an animal; possessing with
19 the intent to distribute, sell, publish, or transmit obscene
20 material depicting a person engaged in a sex act with an
21 animal; or forcing, coercing, enticing, or encouraging a minor
22 to engage in a sex act with an animal.

      The bill provides that a person who performs a sex act with
24 an animal is guilty of an aggravated misdemeanor.
25 or subsequent violation is a class "D" felony. A person
26 who was previously convicted of a violation of Code section
27 717B.2 (animal abuse), 717B.3 (animal neglect), or 717B.3A
28 (animal torture), or 717B.3B (animal mistreatment) who commits
29 bestiality is guilty of a class "D" felony. An aggravated
30 misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no more than two
31 years and a fine of at least $855 but not more than $8,540. A
32 class "D" felony is punishable by confinement for no more than
33 five years and a fine of at least $1,025 but not more than
34 $10,245.
      Current law also requires a person convicted of bestiality

- 1 to submit to a psychological evaluation and treatment at the
- 2 person's expense, in addition to any sentence authorized by
- 3 law.
