## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to determination of school district enrollments
- 2 and education savings account participation and including
- 3 effective date and applicability provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 256.9, Code 2023, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 67. Develop and maintain an internet-based 3 4 method to allow a parent or guardian, prior to the application 5 deadline under section 257.11B, to declare that their child 6 intends to apply for an education savings account for the 7 next school year. Following a submission of intent, the 8 department shall notify the child's district of residence of 9 the declaration of intent, but shall not provide any names of 10 children, parents, or guardians, and shall only provide the ll number of children and the grade level of each child. 12 Sec. 2. Section 256C.5, subsection 1, paragraph c, Code 13 2023, is amended to read as follows: "Preschool budget enrollment" means the figure that is 14 C. 15 equal to fifty percent of the actual enrollment of eligible 16 students in the preschool programming provided by a school 17 district approved to participate in the preschool program on 18 October 1 of the base year, or the first Monday in October if 19 October 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday unless the board of 20 directors adopts and files a resolution with the school budget 21 review committee on or before March 1 following the October 22 determination, in which case the enrollment is determined on 23 that March 1 or the first Monday in March if March 1 falls on a 24 Saturday or Sunday. 25 Sec. 3. Section 257.6, subsection 1, paragraph a, 26 unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2023, is amended to read as 27 follows: Actual enrollment is determined annually on October 1, or 28 29 the first Monday in October if October 1 falls on a Saturday 30 or Sunday unless the board of directors adopts and files a 31 resolution with the school budget review committee on or before 32 March 1 following the October determination, in which case the 33 enrollment is determined on that March 1 or the first Monday 34 in March if March 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday, and includes 35 all of the following:

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1 Sec. 4. Section 257.6, subsection 1, paragraph b, Code 2023, 2 is amended to read as follows: A school district shall certify its actual enrollment 3 b. 4 to the department of education by October 15 of each year, and 5 the department shall promptly forward the information to the 6 department of management. If the board of directors adopts 7 and files a resolution with the school budget review committee 8 as provided in paragraph  $a^{a}$ , the school district shall also 9 certify its modified actual enrollment to the department of 10 education by March 15 and the department shall promptly forward 11 the information to the department of management. 12 Sec. 5. Section 257.6, subsection 3, paragraph a, Code 2023, 13 is amended to read as follows: 14 a. A school district shall determine its additional 15 enrollment because of special education, as defined in this 16 section, by November 1 of each year, or by the first Monday in 17 November if November 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday unless 18 the board of directors adopts and files a resolution with the 19 school budget review committee on or before March 1 following 20 the November determination, in which case the additional 21 enrollment because of special education is determined on that 22 March 1 or the first Monday in March if March 1 falls on a 23 Saturday or Sunday, and shall certify its additional enrollment 24 because of special education to the department of education by 25 November 15 of each year within fifteen days of the applicable 26 determination date, and the department shall promptly forward 27 the information to the department of management. 28 Sec. 6. Section 257.6, subsection 5, paragraph a, Code 2023, 29 is amended to read as follows: Weighted enrollment is the budget enrollment plus the 30 a.

31 district's additional enrollment is the budget enrollment plus the 31 district's additional enrollment because of special education 32 <del>calculated by November 1</del> <u>determined on the applicable date</u> of 33 the base year <u>under subsection 3</u> plus additional pupils added 34 due to the application of the supplementary weighting. 35 Sec. 7. Section 257.6, Code 2023, is amended by adding the

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1 following new subsection:

2 NEW SUBSECTION. 5A. Pupils added due to application of 3 supplementary weighting. A school district shall determine its 4 pupils added due to application of supplementary weighting by 5 October 1 of each year, or by the first Monday in October if 6 October 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday, unless the board of 7 directors adopts and files a resolution with the school budget 8 review committee on or before March 1 following the October 9 determination, in which case the enrollment is determined on 10 that March 1 or the first Monday in March if March 1 falls on a 11 Saturday or Sunday, and shall certify its pupils added due to 12 the application of supplementary weighting to the department of 13 education within fifteen days of the applicable determination 14 date, and the department of education shall promptly forward 15 the information to the department of management. 16 Sec. 8. Section 261E.7, subsection 1, unnumbered paragraph 17 1, Code 2023, is amended to read as follows: Not later than June 30 of each year, a school district 18 19 shall pay a tuition reimbursement amount to a postsecondary 20 institution that has enrolled its resident eligible 21 students under this chapter, unless the eligible student is 22 participating in open enrollment under section 282.18, in 23 which case, the tuition reimbursement amount shall be paid 24 by the receiving district. However, if a child's residency 25 changes during a school year, the tuition shall be paid by the 26 district in which the child was enrolled as of the October 27 date specified in section 257.6, subsection 1, paragraph "a", 28 or the district in which the child was counted under section 29 257.6, subsection 1, paragraph  $a^{\prime}$ , subparagraph (6), as of 30 the October date specified in section 257.6, subsection 1, 31 paragraph "a". For students enrolled at the Iowa school for the 32 deaf and the Iowa braille and sight saving school, the state 33 board of regents shall pay a tuition reimbursement amount by 34 June 30 of each year. The amount of tuition reimbursement for 35 each separate course shall equal the lesser of:

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1 Sec. 9. Section 273.5, subsection 5, Code 2023, is amended
2 to read as follows:

5. Provide Subject to the determination dates under section 4 257.6, annually provide each school district within the area 5 served and the department of education with a special education 6 weighted enrollment count, including the additional enrollment 7 because of special education for December 1 of each year.

8 Sec. 10. Section 279.60, subsection 1, Code 2023, is amended 9 to read as follows:

1. Each school district shall administer the teaching 10 11 strategies gold early childhood assessment to every resident 12 prekindergarten or four-year-old child whose parent or guardian 13 enrolls the child in the district, and shall administer a valid 14 and reliable universal screening instrument, as prescribed by 15 the department of education, to every kindergarten student 16 enrolled in the district not later than the October date 17 specified in section 257.6, subsection 1, paragraph a''. The 18 assessment shall be aligned with state early learning standards 19 and preschool programs shall be encouraged to administer the 20 assessment at least at the beginning and end of the preschool 21 program, with the assessment information entered into the 22 statewide longitudinal data system. The department shall work 23 to develop agreements with head start programs to incorporate 24 similar information about four-year-old children served by head 25 start into the statewide longitudinal data system.

26 Sec. 11. Section 282.12, subsection 4, Code 2023, is amended 27 to read as follows:

4. The number of pupils participating in a whole grade
sharing agreement shall be determined on the <u>October</u> date
specified in section 257.6, subsection 1, <u>paragraph</u> "a", and on
the second Friday of January of each year.

32 Sec. 12. Section 282.18, subsection 7, paragraph a, Code 33 2023, is amended to read as follows:

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34 a. If a parent or guardian of a child, who is participating35 in open enrollment under this section, moves to a different

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1 school district during the course of either district's academic 2 year, the child's first district of residence as determined 3 on the <u>October</u> date specified in section 257.6, subsection 1, 4 shall be responsible for payment of the cost per pupil plus 5 weightings or special education costs to the receiving school 6 district for the balance of the school year in which the move 7 took place. The new district of residence shall be responsible 8 for the payments during succeeding years.

9 Sec. 13. EFFECTIVE DATE. The section of this Act amending 10 section 256.9, being deemed of immediate importance, takes 11 effect upon enactment.

12 Sec. 14. APPLICABILITY. Except for the section of this Act 13 amending section 256.9, this Act applies to actual enrollment 14 determinations for school budget years beginning on or after 15 July 1, 2023.

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## EXPLANATION

17The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with18the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

Code section 257.6(1)(a) provides that each school district's actual enrollment is determined annually on October 1, or the first Monday in October if October 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday. This bill amends the methodology for determining the actual enrollment each year. Under the bill, actual enrollment is determined annually on the applicable October date unless the board of directors adopts and files a resolution with the school budget review committee on or before March 1 following the October determination, in which case the enrollment is determined on that March 1 or the first Monday in March if March 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday.

30 The bill makes corresponding changes to other provisions 31 of law including provisions for preschool enrollment 32 determinations, additional enrollment because of special 33 education, and pupils added due to application of supplementary 34 weighting.

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35 The bill requires the director of the department of

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1 education to develop and maintain an internet-based method to 2 allow a parent or guardian, prior to the application deadline 3 for an education savings account, to declare that their child 4 intends to apply for an education savings account for the next 5 school year. Following a submission of intent, the department 6 of education shall notify the child's district of residence of 7 the declaration of intent, but shall not provide any names of 8 children, parents, or guardians, and shall only provide the 9 number of children and the grade level of each child. 10 The section of the bill amending Code section 256.9 takes 11 effect upon enactment. Except for the section of the bill 12 amending Code section 256.9, the bill applies to actual 13 enrollment determinations for school budget years beginning on 14 or after July 1, 2023.

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
