## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the retrieval of wounded deer by use of a
- 2 registered unmanned aerial vehicle, and providing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 2365

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **481A.56B** Retrieval of wounded deer 2 by use of a registered unmanned aerial vehicle.
- 3 1. A person having a valid hunting license and a valid deer
- 4 hunting license who has wounded a deer while hunting may use a
- 5 registered unmanned aerial vehicle to track and retrieve the
- 6 wounded deer. The person may dispatch the deer using a legal
- 7 method of take authorized by the person's deer hunting license
- 8 consistent with all rules and regulations for that season.
- 9 A person shall not use that method of take to hunt, wound,
- 10 or kill any animal other than the deer that the hunter is
- 11 tracking, except in self-defense. Using a registered unmanned
- 12 aerial vehicle on private property is permissible at any hour
- 13 with consent of the property owner.
- 2. All unmanned aerial vehicles must be registered with
- 15 the department of natural resources and the federal aviation
- 16 administration. The commission shall implement a registration
- 17 procedure for unmanned aerial vehicles to be used in wounded
- 18 deer recovery. The registration requirements must comply
- 19 with the federal aviation administration regulations. The
- 20 commission shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A to
- 21 implement this section.
- Sec. 2. Section 481A.125A, Code 2024, is amended by adding
- 23 the following new subsection:
- NEW SUBSECTION. 5. This section does not apply to the use
- 25 of a registered unmanned aerial vehicles to retrieve a wounded
- 26 deer under section 481A.56B.
- 27 Sec. 3. Section 805.8B, subsection 3, paragraph r, Code
- 28 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 29 r. For violations of section sections 481A.56A and 481A.56B,
- 30 the scheduled fine is two hundred fifty dollars.
- 31 EXPLANATION
- 32 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 33 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 34 This bill allows a person with a valid hunting license and
- 35 deer hunting license who wounds a deer while hunting to use a

- 1 registered unmanned aerial vehicle to track and retrieve the
- 2 wounded deer. The person may dispatch the deer using a legal
- 3 method of take authorized by the person's valid deer hunting
- 4 license. The bill provides that a person may use a registered
- 5 unmanned aerial vehicle to track a wounded deer on private
- 6 property at any time with the consent of the property owner.
- 7 Persons must register the unmanned aerial vehicle for
- 8 wounded deer retrieval with the department of natural resources
- 9 and the federal aviation administration. The natural resource
- 10 commission (NRC) is directed to create a registration process
- 11 that complies with the federal aviation administration's
- 12 regulations for unmanned aerial vehicles. The bill directs NRC
- 13 to adopt rules to implement the bill's provisions.
- 14 A violation of the bill's provisions is punishable by a
- 15 scheduled fine of \$250.
