- Section 1. Section 507B.4, subsection 1, Code 2024, is
 amended to read as follows:

 1. For purposes of subsection 3, paragraph paragraphs "p"
- 4 and v'', insurer'' means an entity providing a plan of health
- 5 insurance, health care benefits, or health care services, or
- 6 an entity subject to the jurisdiction of the commissioner
- 7 performing utilization review, including an insurance company
- 8 offering sickness and accident plans, a health maintenance
- 9 organization, a nonprofit health service corporation, a plan
- 10 established pursuant to chapter 509A for public employees, or
- 11 any other entity providing a plan of health insurance, health
- 12 care benefits, or health care services. However, "insurer" does
- 13 not include an entity that sells disability income insurance.
- 14 Sec. 2. Section 507B.4, subsection 3, Code 2024, is amended
- 15 by adding the following new paragraph:
- 16 NEW PARAGRAPH. v. Failure to negotiate in good
- 17 faith. Failure of an insurer to negotiate in good faith all
- 18 charges with a hospital licensed pursuant to chapter 135B.
- 19 "Good faith" means honesty in fact and the observance of
- 20 reasonable commercial standards of fair dealing in the trade.
- 21 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 24 This bill relates to an insurer's duty of good faith in
- 25 negotiations. Under the bill, it shall be an unfair method
- 26 of competition and unfair or deceptive act or practice in the
- 27 business of insurance for an insurer to fail to negotiate in
- 28 good faith all charges with a hospital licensed pursuant to
- 29 Code chapter 135B. "Good faith" is defined by the bill as
- 30 honesty in fact and the observance of reasonable commercial
- 31 standards of fair dealing in the trade. "Insurer" is also
- 32 defined in the bill.
