A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to school lunch programs provided by school
- 2 districts and accredited nonpublic schools and making
- 3 appropriations.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 283A.6 Free school lunch program.
- 2 l. Each school district described in chapter 274 and each
- 3 accredited nonpublic school shall operate a program under which
- 4 lunches are served to students in attendance at no charge to
- 5 the student or the student's family. Meals served pursuant to
- 6 this subsection shall be nutritionally adequate meals.
- 7 2. For the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and for
- 8 each fiscal year thereafter, there is appropriated from the
- 9 general fund of the state to the department of education an
- 10 amount necessary to make the payments to school districts and
- 11 accredited nonpublic schools necessary to cover the costs of
- 12 providing school lunches pursuant to this section that are not
- 13 covered by any Act of Congress and appropriated to the state of
- 14 Iowa for use in connection with school lunch programs.
- 15 3. The state board of education shall adopt rules pursuant
- 16 to chapter 17A to administer this section.
- Sec. 2. Section 283A.10, Code 2024, is amended to read as
- 18 follows:
- 19 283A.10 School breakfast or lunch in nonpublic schools.
- 20 The Unless required under section 283A.6, the authorities
- 21 in charge of nonpublic schools may operate or provide for the
- 22 operation of school breakfast or lunch programs in schools
- 23 under their jurisdiction and may use funds appropriated to
- 24 them by the general assembly, gifts, funds received from sale
- 25 of school breakfasts or lunches under such programs, and any
- 26 other funds available to the nonpublic school. However,
- 27 unless required under section 283A.6, school breakfast or
- 28 lunch programs shall not be required in nonpublic schools.
- 29 The department of education shall direct the disbursement of
- 30 state funds to nonpublic schools for school breakfast or lunch
- 31 programs in the same manner as state funds are disbursed to
- 32 public schools. If a nonpublic school receives state funds for
- 33 the operation of a school breakfast or lunch program, meals

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- 34 served under the program shall be nutritionally adequate meals,
- 35 as defined in section 283A.1.

6	The bill requires each school to operate a program under
7	which lunches are served to students in attendance at no charge
8	to the student or the student's family.
9	The bill appropriates from the general fund of the state to
L O	the department of education an amount necessary to make the
L1	payments to schools necessary to cover the costs of providing
L 2	free school lunches that are not covered by any Act of Congress
L3	and appropriated to the state of Iowa for use in connection
L 4	with school lunch programs. The bill requires the state board
L 5	of education to adopt rules to administer these provisions.
L 6	The bill makes conforming changes.
