HOUSE FILE 2417 BY THOMSON

A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to certain motor vehicle equipment, including
- 2 required signage regarding such equipment, and making
- 3 penalties applicable.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **321.447 Remote disabling** 2 prohibited.
- 3 A person shall not operate a motor vehicle equipped with a
- 4 system or technology capable of remotely disabling the vehicle
- 5 while the vehicle is being operated.
- 6 Sec. 2. NEW SECTION. 321.448 AM radio required.
- 7 A person shall not operate a motor vehicle unless the vehicle
- 8 is equipped with a functional radio capable of receiving
- 9 commercial radio station transmissions utilizing amplitude
- 10 modulation technology between the frequencies of five hundred
- 11 forty kilohertz and one thousand seven hundred kilohertz.
- 12 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 321.448A Signs required.
- 13 The department shall post permanent signs, meeting the
- 14 specified requirements in the department manual on uniform
- 15 traffic-control devices, giving notice of the motor vehicle
- 16 equipment prohibited under section 321.447 and required under
- 17 section 321.448 at the location where any highway enters the
- 18 boundaries of this state.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 22 This bill prohibits a person from operating a motor vehicle
- 23 in Iowa if the vehicle is equipped with a system or technology
- 24 capable of remotely disabling the vehicle while the vehicle is
- 25 being operated.
- 26 The bill requires every motor vehicle operated in Iowa to be
- 27 equipped with a functional radio capable of receiving certain
- 28 commercial radio station transmissions (AM radio).
- 29 By operation of law, a person who operates a motor vehicle
- 30 equipped with a vehicle-disabling system or technology and
- 31 a person who operates a motor vehicle without a functional
- 32 AM radio equipped commits a simple misdemeanor. A simple
- 33 misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no more than 30
- 34 days and a fine of at least \$105 but not more than \$855.
- 35 The department of transportation is required to post

- 1 permanent signs, meeting the specified requirements in the
- 2 department manual on uniform traffic-control devices, giving
- 3 notice of the prohibition against operating a motor vehicle
- 4 equipped with a vehicle-disabling system or technology and the
- 5 requirement for a motor vehicle to be equipped with an AM radio
- 6 at the location where any highway enters the boundaries of
- 7 Iowa.
