A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act providing for state employee parental leave.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 70A.31 Paid parental leave.
- A state employee entitled to leave under the federal
- 3 Family and Medical Leave Act of 1993 shall be provided paid
- 4 leave for such time as specified in this section for the birth
- 5 of a child or placement of a child for adoption with the
- 6 employee if the leave is taken within twelve months following
- 7 any such birth or adoption.
- 8 2. a. For the birth of a child, a state employee parent who
- 9 gave birth shall be entitled to up to four weeks of paid leave
- 10 and a state employee parent who did not give birth shall be
- 11 entitled to up to one week of paid leave.
- 12 b. For the placement of a child for adoption, a state
- 13 employee parent shall be entitled to up to four weeks of paid
- 14 leave.
- 15 3. The department of administrative services shall adopt
- 16 rules pursuant to chapter 17A to implement this section.
- 17 EXPLANATION
- 18 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 19 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 20 This bill provides that a state employee entitled to leave
- 21 under the federal Family and Medical Leave Act of 1993 shall
- 22 be provided paid leave for the birth or adoption of a child if
- 23 the leave is taken within 12 months following any such birth
- 24 or adoption. The bill provides that a state employee parent
- 25 who gives birth or adopts a child shall be entitled to up to
- 26 four weeks of paid leave. A state employee parent who did not
- 27 give birth shall be entitled to up to one week of paid leave.
- 28 The bill requires the department of administrative services to
- 29 adopt rules to implement the bill.
