# A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to vehicles, including the initial registration
- 2 and issuance of certificate of title by certain county
- 3 treasurers and the definitions of terms for purposes of
- 4 motor vehicle franchisers, and providing fees.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 321.20, subsection 4, Code 2024, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- Notwithstanding this section or any other provision of
- 4 law to the contrary, if the program required by subsection
- 5 2 is not implemented by July 1, 2019, an owner of a vehicle
- 6 subject to registration or a lessor of a vehicle pursuant to
- 7 chapter 321F that is subject to registration and has a gross
- 8 vehicle weight of less than ten thousand pounds, may apply
- 9 to the county treasurer of a county contiguous to the county
- 10 designated for the owner under subsection 1 for the initial
- 11 registration and issuance of a certificate of title. However,
- 12 any reference in this chapter to the county where a vehicle
- 13 is registered or the county where a certificate of title was
- 14 issued shall be deemed to refer to the applicable county
- 15 described in subsection 1, regardless of which county treasurer
- 16 received application for and issued the initial registration
- 17 and certificate of title under this subsection. The fee for
- 18 submitting an application under this subsection is one dollar,
- 19 which is in addition to any other fee provided by law.
- Sec. 2. Section 321.166, subsection 2, Code 2024, is amended
- 21 to read as follows:
- 22 2. Every registration plate or pair of plates shall display
- 23 a registration plate number which shall consist of alphabetical
- 24 or numerical characters or a combination thereof and the name
- 25 of this state, which may be abbreviated. Every registration
- 26 plate issued by the county treasurer shall display the name
- 27 of the county, including any plate issued pursuant to section
- 28 321.34, except Pearl Harbor and purple heart registration
- 29 plates issued prior to January 1, 1997; and collegiate,
- 30 fire fighter, and medal of honor registration plates; and
- 31 regular registration plates issued pursuant to section
- 32 321.20, subsection 4. Special truck registration plates shall
- 33 display the word "special". The department may adopt rules to
- 34 implement this subsection.
- 35 Sec. 3. Section 322A.1, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 2024,

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1 is amended to read as follows:

When The following words and phrases when used in this

- 3 chapter shall, unless the context otherwise requires for
- 4 the purpose of this chapter, have the meanings respectively
- 5 ascribed to them:
- 6 EXPLANATION
- 7 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 9 Under current law, a person must generally apply for vehicle
- 10 registration and issuance of certificate of title to the county
- 11 treasurer where the person resides or where the primary users
- 12 of the vehicle are located. However, in 2016, the general
- 13 assembly required the department of transportation (DOT) to
- 14 develop and implement, by January 1, 2018, a program to allow
- 15 for electronic applications, titling, registering, and funds
- 16 transfers for vehicles subject to registration (program) in
- 17 order to improve the efficiency and timeliness of the processes
- 18 and to reduce costs for all parties involved. At the same
- 19 time, the general assembly conditionally authorized an owner
- 20 of a vehicle subject to registration to apply to the county
- 21 treasurer of a county contiguous to the county designated for
- 22 the owner if the DOT had not yet implemented the program by
- 23 January 1, 2018. In 2018, the general assembly amended the
- 24 program implementation date to July 1, 2019.
- 25 This bill authorizes a lessor of a vehicle pursuant to Code
- 26 chapter 321F (leasing and renting of vehicles), if such vehicle
- 27 is subject to registration and has a gross vehicle weight of
- 28 less than 10,000 pounds, to apply for initial registration
- 29 and issuance of certificate of title in a contiguous county.
- 30 The bill does not make corresponding changes. Instead, for
- 31 all registration and certificate of title actions provided or
- 32 required in Code chapter 321 (motor vehicles and law of the
- 33 road) other than initial registrations and certificates of
- 34 title issued in a contiguous county, references to the county
- 35 where a vehicle is registered or the county where a certificate

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- 1 of title was issued are deemed to refer to the appropriate 2 county under current law. The bill requires an applicant for
- 3 initial registration and issuance of certificate of title to
- 4 pay a \$1 application fee if the application is submitted in a
- 5 contiguous county. The fee is in addition to any other fee
- 6 provided by law.
- 7 Current law requires registration plates to display the
- 8 name of the county that issues the plates, unless a specific
- 9 exception is provided. The bill specifies such an exception
- 10 for regular registration plates issued pursuant to the bill.
- 11 The bill removes the context clause applicable to defined
- 12 terms in Code chapter 322A (motor vehicle franchisers). In
- 13 2022, the Iowa supreme court relied on the context clause
- 14 included in Code section 322A.1 to apply an alternate
- 15 definition of "community" than how "community" is defined in
- 16 Code chapter 322A (Sioux City Truck Sales, Inc. v. Iowa Dept.
- 17 of Transportation, 975 N.W.2d 333 (Iowa 2022)). The bill
- 18 provides the same introduction to defined words and phrases to
- 19 Code chapter 322A as is used for Code chapter 321.
