- 1 An Act establishing a diminished salary offset for unemployment
- benefits.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 96.3, Code 2023, is amended by adding the 2 following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 5A. Diminished salary offset. If an
- 4 individual receiving benefits accepts an offer of employment
- 5 prior to the exhausting of all benefits for the individual's
- 6 benefit year and the gross weekly salary is less than the
- 7 individual's weekly benefit amount, the individual shall be
- 8 eligible to receive an amount equal to the difference between
- 9 the individual's gross weekly salary and the individual's
- 10 weekly benefit amount. Benefits shall be exhausted when the
- 11 individual's gross weekly salary paid plus benefits received
- 12 equal or are greater than the maximum total amount of benefits
- 13 payable to the individual during the benefit year.
- 14 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 17 This bill establishes a diminished salary offset for
- 18 unemployment benefits whereby an individual who accepts
- 19 employment with a gross weekly salary less than the
- 20 individual's weekly unemployment benefit amount may receive an
- 21 amount equal to the difference between the individual's gross
- 22 weekly salary and the individual's weekly benefit amount if
- 23 the individual accepts such employment prior to exhausting the
- 24 individual's benefits for the individual's benefit year. The
- 25 individual's benefits shall be exhausted when the individual's
- 26 gross weekly salary paid plus benefits received are equal to or
- 27 greater than the maximum total amount of benefits payable to
- 28 the individual during the benefit year.
