1 Section 1. ENVIRONMENTAL CONTAMINANTS — HUMAN FERTILITY 2 AND HUMAN ENDOCRINE SYSTEM - STUDY - REPORT. The department 3 of health and human services shall compile and analyze 4 information, data, scientific research, and other sources on 5 the negative effects of environmental contaminants on human 6 fertility and the human endocrine system, with an emphasis 7 on intrauterine exposure, and shall submit a report to 8 the governor and the general assembly by February 1, 2024, 9 specifying the department's findings and recommendations for 10 broad-based policy strategies to prevent and reduce these 11 negative effects through actions and interventions at the 12 patient, health care provider, health care institution, and 13 societal levels. 14 **EXPLANATION** 15 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly. 17 This bill requires the department of health and human 18 services to compile and analyze studies, data, scientific 19 research, and other sources on the negative effects of 20 environmental contaminants on human fertility and the human 21 endocrine system, with an emphasis on intrauterine exposure, 22 and to submit a report to the governor and the general assembly 23 specifying the department's findings and recommendations for 24 broad-based policy strategies to prevent and reduce these 25 negative effects through actions and interventions at the 26 patient, health care provider, health care institution, and 27 societal levels.
