- 1 Section 1. Section 331.301, Code 2023, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 22. A county shall not adopt an ordinance,
- 4 motion, resolution, or amendment, or use any other means, that
- 5 establishes, intentionally or effectively, a maximum limit of
- 6 egg-laying hens allowed on a property that is less than three
- 7 egg-laying hens per resident of the property. This subsection
- 8 does not prohibit the lessor of a property from limiting the
- 9 number of egg-laying hens a lessee has on the property.
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 364.3, Code 2023, is amended by adding the 11 following new subsection:
- 12 NEW SUBSECTION. 18. A city shall not adopt an ordinance,
- 13 motion, resolution, or amendment, or use any other means, that
- 14 establishes, intentionally or effectively, a maximum limit of
- 15 egg-laying hens allowed on a property that is less than three
- 16 egg-laying hens per resident of the property. This subsection
- 17 does not prohibit the lessor of a property from limiting the
- 18 number of egg-laying hens a lessee has on the property.
