- 1 An Act relating to recitation of the state motto in school

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

TLSB 2189YH (1) 90 jda/jh 1 Section 1. Section 280.5, Code 2023, is amended to read as
2 follows:

280.5 Display of United States flag and Iowa state flag —
4 pledge of allegiance — state motto.

5 1. The board of directors of each public school district 6 and the authorities in charge of each nonpublic school shall 7 provide and maintain a suitable flagstaff on each school site 8 under its control, and the United States flag and the Iowa 9 state flag shall be raised on all school days when weather 10 conditions are suitable.

11 2. <u>a.</u> The board of directors of each public school district 12 shall administer the pledge of allegiance in grades one through 13 twelve each school day. Each classroom in which the pledge of 14 allegiance is recited pursuant to this subsection shall display 15 the United States flag during the recitation. A student shall 16 not be compelled against the student's objections or those of 17 the student's parent or guardian to recite the pledge.

18 b. After administering the pledge of allegiance, the board 19 of directors of each public school district shall require 20 students enrolled in grades one through twelve to recite the 21 state motto established under section 1A.1. A student shall 22 not be compelled against the student's objections or those of 23 the student's parent or guardian to recite the state motto.

EXPLANATION

29 Current law requires school districts to administer the 30 pledge of allegiance in grades 1 through 12 each school 31 day. The bill provides that, after administering the pledge 32 of allegiance, students enrolled in grades 1 through 12 in 33 school districts are required to recite the state motto, 34 "our liberties we prize, and our rights we will maintain". 35 Additionally, the bill provides that a student shall not be
