## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to employer liability for adverse effects
- 2 resulting from mandated COVID-19 vaccinations.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 686D.2, Code 2023, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsections:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 1A. "COVID-19 vaccine" means a vaccine or
- 4 immunization approved by the centers for disease control and
- 5 prevention of the United States department of health and human
- 6 services to prevent COVID-19.
- 7 NEW SUBSECTION. 2A. "Employee" means an individual who is
- 8 employed in this state for wages by an employer. "Employee"
- 9 includes an applicant for employment.
- 10 NEW SUBSECTION. 2B. "Employer" means a person who employs
- ll an individual in this state for wages.
- 12 Sec. 2. Section 686D.8, subsection 1, Code 2023, is amended
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 l. Create, recognize, or ratify a claim or cause of action
- 15 of any kind, except for the cause of action created pursuant
- 16 to section 686D.9.
- 17 Sec. 3. NEW SECTION. 686D.9 Mandated COVID-19 vaccines -
- 18 employer liability.
- 19 1. An employee may bring a civil claim against an employer
- 20 in a court of competent jurisdiction for damages for injury,
- 21 illness, or adverse effects resulting from a COVID-19 vaccine
- 22 if the employer required the employee to receive the COVID-19
- 23 vaccine as a condition of employment.
- 24 2. The employer bears the burden to prove by a preponderance
- 25 of the evidence that the employer is not liable or responsible
- 26 for any injuries, illness, or adverse effects resulting from
- 27 the employee receiving a COVID-19 vaccine.
- 28 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 30 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 31 This bill relates to employer liability for an employer
- 32 that implements an employee COVID-19 vaccination mandate. The
- 33 bill defines "COVID-19 vaccine", "employee", and "employer".
- 34 The bill provides that an employee may bring a civil claim
- 35 against an employer if the employee was required to receive

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- 1 a COVID-19 vaccine and suffered an injury, illness, or other
- 2 adverse effect from the required vaccine. The burden of proof
- 3 rests on the employer to show that the employer is not liable
- 4 or responsible for any injury resulting from the employee
- 5 receiving a COVID-19 vaccine.
