- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 256C.5, subsection 1, paragraph c, Code 2 2023, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 c. "Preschool budget enrollment" means the figure that is
- 4 equal to fifty percent of the actual enrollment of eligible
- 5 students in the preschool programming provided by a school
- 6 district approved to participate in the preschool program on
- 7 October 1 of the base year, or the first Monday in October if
- 8 October 1 falls on a Saturday or Sunday.
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 256C.5, subsection 2, paragraph a, Code
- 10 2023, is amended to read as follows:
- ll a. For the initial school year for which a school district
- 12 approved to participate in the preschool program receives that
- 13 approval and implements the preschool program, the funding for
- 14 the preschool foundation aid payable to that school district
- 15 shall be paid from the appropriation made for that school year
- 16 in section 256C.6, Code 2011, or in another appropriation
- 17 made for purposes of this chapter. For that school year, the
- 18 preschool foundation aid payable to the school district is
- 19 the product of the regular program state cost per pupil for
- 20 the school year multiplied by sixty percent of the school
- 21 district's eligible student enrollment on the date in the
- 22 school year determined by rule.
- 23 Sec. 3. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies July 1, 2024, for
- 24 school budget years beginning on or after that date.
- 25 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 27 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 28 This bill relates to funding for the statewide preschool
- 29 program for four-year-old children under Code chapter 256C.
- 30 The amount of state funding for each school district's
- 31 approved local program is determined using a preschool budget
- 32 enrollment that is equal to 50 percent of the actual enrollment
- 33 of eligible students in the preschool programming provided by
- 34 a school district on October 1 of the base year. The bill
- 35 changes the preschool budget enrollment used to determine

- 1 funding to an amount equal to 100 percent of the actual
- 2 enrollment of eligible students in the preschool programming
- 3 provided by a school district on October 1 of the base
- 4 year. The bill also modifies the funding calculation for the
- 5 initial school year for which a school district is approved to
- 6 participate in the program.
- 7 The bill applies to school budget years beginning on or after
- 8 July 1, 2024.
