- 1 An Act relating to a prohibition on hazardous liquid pipelines
- 2 transporting liquefied carbon dioxide, and including
- 3 effective date and applicability provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 479B.4, subsection 1, Code 2023, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 1. A pipeline company doing business in this state shall.
- 4 subject to subsection 7, file a verified petition with the
- 5 board asking for a permit to construct, maintain, and operate
- 6 a new pipeline along, over, or across the public or private
- 7 highways, grounds, waters, and streams of any kind in this
- 8 state. Any pipeline company now owning or operating a pipeline
- 9 or underground storage facility in this state shall be issued a
- 10 permit by the board upon supplying the information as provided
- 11 for in section 479B.5, subsections 1 through 5, and meeting the
- 12 requirements of section 479B.13.
- 13 Sec. 2. Section 479B.4, Code 2023, is amended by adding the
- 14 following new subsection:
- 15 NEW SUBSECTION. 7. The board shall not grant a permit to a
- 16 pipeline company for a pipeline transporting liquefied carbon
- 17 dioxide.
- 18 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 19 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 20 Sec. 4. APPLICABILITY. This Act applies to pipeline
- 21 companies that have yet to be granted a permit from the board
- 22 on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 23 EXPLANATION
- 24 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 25 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 26 This bill relates to prohibiting hazardous liquid pipelines
- 27 transporting liquefied carbon dioxide.
- 28 The bill prohibits the Iowa utilities board from issuing
- 29 a permit for a pipeline company constructing a pipeline
- 30 transporting liquefied carbon dioxide in the state.
- 31 The bill takes effect upon enactment and applies to pipeline
- 32 companies that have yet to be granted a permit from the Iowa
- 33 utilities board on or after the effective date of the bill.
