A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to purchasing of tires from the state by
2 certain volunteer emergency services providers.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 100B.46 Volunteer emergency
2 services providers — tires.

3 1. For purposes of this section, "volunteer emergency
4 services provider" means any of the following:

5 a. A volunteer fire fighter as defined in section 85.61.

6 b. A person performing the functions of an emergency medical
7 care provider as defined in section 147A.1 who is not paid
8 full-time by the entity for which such services are being
9 performed.

10 c. A reserve peace officer as defined in section 80D.1A.

11 2. A volunteer emergency services provider shall be
12 authorized to purchase from the department of administrative
13 services during any calendar year no more than one set of tires
14 under a master contract for tires established by the department
15 of administrative services as provided in section 8A.311A.

16 3. The department of administrative services shall adopt
17 rules governing the requirements of this section.

18 EXPLANATION

19 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
20 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

21 This bill provides that a volunteer emergency services
22 provider shall be authorized to purchase no more than one
23 set of tires under a master contract for tires established
24 by the department of administrative services (DAS). The
25 bill defines a volunteer emergency services provider as a
26 volunteer fire fighter, a person performing the functions of
27 an emergency medical care provider who is not paid full-time,
28 or a reserve peace officer. DAS shall adopt rules governing
29 the requirements of the bill.
