5	provider for the time a child is regularly scheduled to receive
6	child care at a child care facility regardless of whether
7	the child is in attendance on those regularly scheduled days
8	provided that the child care provider would charge a private
9	individual for the scheduled child care.

- 13 This bill relates to child care assistance payments for 14 children who are absent from regularly scheduled child care 15 days.
- The bill directs the department of health and human services to amend its rules to require that state child care assistance program payments be made to a child care provider for the time a child is regularly scheduled to receive child care at a child care facility regardless of whether the child is in attendance during those regularly scheduled days provided that the child care provider would charge a private individual for
