12 This bill relates to minimum eligibility requirements for 13 Iowa law enforcement officers.

14 Under current law, no person may be selected or appointed as 15 a law enforcement officer unless the person is a citizen of the 16 United States.

17 The bill directs the Iowa law enforcement academy to amend 18 its administrative rules concerning general eligibility 19 requirements for law enforcement officers to also allow a 20 person who is a lawful resident of the United States who has 21 been in the United States legally for at least five years and 22 has legal authorization to work in the United States to be 23 selected or appointed as a law enforcement officer.
