A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to van-accessible persons with disabilities
- 2 parking spaces and signs.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 321L.6, subsection 1, Code 2023, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 l. a. The persons with disabilities parking sign shall
- 4 have a blue background and bear the international symbol of
- 5 accessibility in white.
- 6 b. For an off-street public parking facility containing two
- 7 or more persons with disabilities parking spaces, the entity
- 8 that owns or leases the property shall display the words "Van
- 9 Accessible Priority Parking" on van-accessible persons with
- 10 disabilities parking signs.
- 11 c. If an entity who that owns or leases real property in a
- 12 city is required to provide persons with disabilities parking
- 13 spaces, the city shall provide, upon request, the signs for
- 14 the entity at cost. If an entity who that owns or leases real
- 15 property outside the corporate limits of a city is required to
- 16 provide persons with disabilities parking spaces, the county
- 17 in which the property is located shall provide the signs for
- 18 the entity at cost upon request.
- 19 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 22 Under current law, persons with disabilities parking signs
- 23 must have a blue background and bear the international symbol
- 24 of accessibility in white. For an off-street public parking
- 25 facility containing two or more persons with disabilities
- 26 parking spaces, this bill requires the entity that owns or
- 27 leases the property to display the words "Van Accessible
- 28 Priority Parking" on the van-accessible persons with
- 29 disabilities parking signs.
- 30 Pursuant to the federal Americans with Disabilities Act
- 31 (ADA), van-accessible spaces are required to have two signs,
- 32 mounted at least 60 inches above the ground with the first sign
- 33 displaying the international symbol of accessibility and the
- 34 second sign stating that the space is van accessible. The ADA
- 35 requirements are not affected by the bill.
