## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to circumstances necessary prior to deployment
- of state military units in active combat or hazardous
- 3 service related to conflict in a foreign state.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 522

- 1 Section 1. Section 29A.53, Code 2023, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsections:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 4 the Code, the national guard, the air national guard, and the
- 5 civil air patrol shall not be released from this state into
- 6 active combat or into hazardous service relating to an armed
- 7 conflict in a foreign state pursuant to Article I, section 8,
- 8 clause 15, of the United States Constitution, unless the United
- 9 States has officially declared war for the express purpose
- 10 of repelling an invasion, suppressing an insurrection, or
- 11 executing the laws of the United States.
- 12 NEW SUBSECTION. 5. This section shall not be construed
- 13 to limit the authority of the governor to consent to the
- 14 deployment of troops pursuant to Tit. 32 of the United States
- 15 Code.
- 16 Sec. 2. FEDERAL POWERS TO DECLARE WAR LEGISLATIVE
- 17 FINDINGS. The general assembly finds that Article I, section
- 18 8, of the Constitution of the United States solely vests
- 19 the power to declare war in the United States Congress, and
- 20 Congress, by abdicating its war powers to the president, has
- 21 failed to follow the Constitution of the United States and the
- 22 intent of its creators.
- 23 EXPLANATION
- 24 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 26 This bill prohibits the national guard, the air national
- 27 guard, and the civil air patrol from being released from this
- 28 state into active combat or into hazardous service relating
- 29 to an armed conflict in a foreign state unless the United
- 30 States has officially declared war for the express purpose
- 31 of repelling an invasion, suppressing an insurrection, or
- 32 executing the laws of the United States. The bill does
- 33 not limit the authority of the governor to consent to the
- 34 deployment of troops for defense support of civil authorities.
