- 1 An Act relating to baseball broadcasting blackouts.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **477A.13 Baseball broadcasting**
- 2 blackout prohibition.
- 3 1. For purposes of this section, "blackout" means the
- 4 nonairing of a cable, video, or satellite sporting event
- 5 broadcast on a local broadcast station.
- 6 2. For purposes of this section, "sports broadcasting
- 7 entity" means and includes all of the following:
- 8 a. An internet-based streaming platform with over two and a
- 9 one-half million subscribers that allows for the live viewing
- 10 of official major league baseball broadcasts.
- 11 b. A person providing cable service or video service in this
- 12 state.
- 3. A sports broadcasting entity shall be prohibited from
- 14 preventing major league baseball broadcasting through a
- 15 blackout to paying customers of the sports broadcasting entity.
- 16 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 19 This bill relates to baseball broadcasting blackouts.
- The bill defines "blackout" to mean the nonairing of a cable,
- 21 video, or satellite sporting event that is broadcast on a local
- 22 broadcast station. The bill defines "sports broadcasting
- 23 entity" to mean and include specified internet-based streaming
- 24 platforms and a person providing cable service or video service
- 25 in Iowa. The bill prohibits a sports broadcasting entity
- 26 from preventing major league baseball broadcasting through a
- 27 blackout to paying customers.
