## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act limiting campaign contributions to certain candidates,
- 2 and making penalties applicable.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 596

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **68A.507 Contribution limits for** 2 candidates.
- 3 1. For the purposes of this section, "election campaign
- 4 cycle" means the time period between elections for a particular
- 5 office. Each primary, general, and special election is a
- 6 separate election campaign cycle. Separate contribution limits
- 7 for each type of election for a particular office, including
- 8 primary, general, and special elections, apply in an election
- 9 campaign cycle.
- 10 2. A person shall not make, and a candidate for the office
- 11 of a statewide elected official as defined in section 68B.2,
- 12 the candidate's committee, or anyone acting on behalf of the
- 13 candidate or candidate's committee shall not accept, any
- 14 contribution which will cause the total amount of the person's
- 15 contributions to the candidate or candidate's committee to
- 16 exceed the following amounts for an election campaign cycle:
- 17 a. From a political committee, four thousand dollars.
- 18 b. From a national political party, state statutory
- 19 political committee, or county statutory political committee,
- 20 forty thousand dollars.
- 21 c. From any other natural person, four thousand dollars.
- 3. A person shall not make, and a candidate for state
- 23 senator or state representative, the candidate's committee,
- 24 or anyone acting on behalf of the candidate or candidate's
- 25 committee shall not accept, any contribution which will cause
- 26 the total amount of the person's contributions to the candidate
- 27 or candidate's committee to exceed the following amounts for an
- 28 election campaign cycle:
- 29 a. From a political committee, one thousand dollars.
- 30 b. From a national political party, state statutory
- 31 political committee, or county statutory political committee,
- 32 ten thousand dollars.
- 33 c. From any other natural person, one thousand dollars.
- 34 EXPLANATION
- 35 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with

the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

- This bill imposes campaign contribution limits on candidates for statewide elected office and candidates for state senator or representative. In an election campaign cycle for statewide elected office, a political committee shall not contribute more than \$4,000 to one candidate; a national political party, state statutory political committee, or county statutory political committee shall not contribute more than \$40,000; and any other natural person shall not contribute more than \$4,000. For a candidate for state senator or representative, a political committee shall not contribute more than \$1,000; a national political party, state statutory political committee, or county statutory political committee shall not contribute more than \$1,000; and any other natural person shall not contribute more
- A person who violates the bill is subject to penalties pursuant to Code section 68B.32D. A person who willfully la violates the bill is guilty of a serious misdemeanor (Code section 68A.701). A serious misdemeanor is punishable by confinement for no more than one year and a fine of at least 21 \$430 but not more than \$2,560.

A variety of civil remedies are also available in Code 23 section 68B.32D for a violation of Code chapter 68A or rules 24 of the ethics and campaign disclosure board, ranging from a 25 reprimand to a civil penalty of not more than \$2,000.
