## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act providing for the issuance of annual statewide licenses
- 2 for certain establishments offering food for sale, including
- 3 license fees, and including effective date provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

## H.F. 661

- 1 Section 1. Section 137F.6, subsection 1, paragraphs c and h,
- 2 Code 2023, are amended to read as follows:
- c. For a temporary food establishment for multiple
- 4 nonconcurrent events during a calendar year, one annual
- 5 license fee of two hundred dollars for each establishment on
- 6 a countywide statewide basis.
- 7 h. For a farmers market where time/temperature control for
- 8 safety food is sold or distributed, one annual license fee
- 9 of one hundred fifty dollars for each vendor on a countywide
- 10 statewide basis.
- 11 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 12 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 13 EXPLANATION
- 14 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 16 This bill provides for the licensure of certain food
- 17 establishments under the regulatory jurisdiction of the
- 18 department of inspections and appeals (DIA) or a political
- 19 subdivision that has entered into a contract with DIA (together
- 20 termed a "regulatory authority") under Code chapter 137F.
- 21 Specifically, the bill amends provisions for a temporary food
- 22 establishment that operates for not more than 14 consecutive
- 23 days in conjunction with a single event and at multiple
- 24 nonconcurrent events during a calendar year (Code sections
- 25 137F.1 and 137F.6). The license fee is \$200. A farmers market
- 26 is subject to regulation as a food establishment if its vendor
- 27 sells unpackaged foods that must be temperature controlled such
- 28 as meat, poultry, dairy products, cooked or prepared foods,
- 29 or soft pies requiring refrigeration (see 481 IAC 31.5). The
- 30 license fee is \$150. In each case, the license is valid on a
- 31 countywide basis. The bill amends Code section 137F.6(1) by
- 32 providing that the license is valid on a statewide basis.
- 33 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
