A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act establishing a neighborhood housing renovation grant
- 2 program and fund, and making appropriations.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 16.230 Neighborhood housing 2 renovation grant program fund.
- a. A neighborhood housing renovation grant fund
- 4 is created in the state treasury under the control of the
- 5 authority. The fund shall be used to award grants under the
- 6 neighborhood housing renovation grant program.
- 7 b. There is appropriated to the authority for deposit in the
- 8 neighborhood housing renovation grant fund for the fiscal year
- 9 beginning July 1, 2023, from the moneys available to the state
- 10 pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Pub.
- 11 L. No. 117-2, the sum of fifty million dollars.
- 12 c. Notwithstanding section 12C.7, subsection 2, interest
- 13 or earnings on moneys in the neighborhood housing renovation
- 14 grant fund shall accrue to the authority and shall be used for
- 15 purposes of this section. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys
- 16 in the neighborhood housing renovation grant fund at the end of
- 17 each fiscal year shall not revert to any other fund but shall
- 18 remain in the neighborhood housing renovation grant fund for
- 19 expenditure for subsequent fiscal years. All repayments or
- 20 recaptures of grants awarded under this section shall accrue to
- 21 the authority and shall be used for purposes of this section.
- 22 d. The authority shall not use more than three percent of
- 23 the moneys in the neighborhood housing renovation grant fund at
- 24 the beginning of the fiscal year for purposes of administrative
- 25 costs, marketing, and other program support.
- 26 2. a. The authority shall establish and administer a
- 27 neighborhood housing renovation grant program for purposes of
- 28 awarding grants to eligible homeowners for qualifying exterior
- 29 home improvements, repairs, or renovations.
- 30 b. To qualify for the neighborhood housing renovation grant
- 31 program, a homeowner's household income shall not exceed one
- 32 hundred nine thousand dollars.
- 33 c. The property at which the qualifying exterior home
- 34 improvements, repairs, or renovations will occur must be
- 35 occupied by the homeowner.

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- 1 d. A grant awarded under the neighborhood housing renovation
- 2 grant program shall not exceed twenty thousand dollars.
- 3 e. Exterior improvements, repairs, and renovations that
- 4 qualify for the neighborhood housing renovation grant program
- 5 shall include all of the following:
- 6 (1) Roof repair or replacement.
- 7 (2) Foundation repair.
- 8 (3) Exterior siding repair or replacement.
- 9 (4) Exterior paint.
- 10 (5) Window and door repair or replacement.
- 11 (6) Garage repair or replacement.
- 12 (7) Exterior energy efficiency-related repairs or upgrades.
- 13 (8) Exterior wheelchair or mobility assistive device
- 14 accessibility.
- 15 (9) Sidewalk and driveway repair or replacement.
- 16 3. The authority shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A
- 17 to administer this section.
- 18 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 21 This bill establishes a neighborhood housing renovation
- 22 grant program (program) and fund (neighborhood fund) to
- 23 be administered by the Iowa finance authority (authority)
- 24 for purposes of awarding grants to eligible homeowners for
- 25 qualifying exterior home improvements, repairs, or renovations
- 26 (exterior work).
- 27 There is appropriated to the authority for deposit in the
- 28 neighborhood fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023,
- 29 from the moneys available to the state pursuant to the federal
- 30 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, the sum of \$50 million.
- 31 Notwithstanding Code section 12C.7(2), interest or earnings on
- 32 moneys in the neighborhood fund shall accrue to the authority
- 33 and shall be used for purposes of the program. Notwithstanding
- 34 Code section 8.33, moneys in the neighborhood fund at the end
- 35 of each fiscal year shall not revert to any other fund but

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- 1 shall remain in the neighborhood fund for expenditure for
- 2 subsequent fiscal years. All repayments or recaptures of the
- 3 grants awarded under the program shall accrue to the authority
- 4 and shall be used for purposes of the program.
- 5 The authority shall not use more than 3 percent of the moneys
- 6 in the neighborhood fund at the beginning of the fiscal year
- 7 for purposes of administrative costs, marketing, and other
- 8 program support.
- 9 To qualify for the program, a homeowner's household income
- 10 shall not exceed \$109,000 and the homeowner must occupy the
- ll property at which the exterior work will occur. A grant
- 12 awarded under the program shall not exceed \$20,000. Exterior
- 13 work that qualifies for the program is detailed in the bill.
- 14 The authority shall adopt rules to administer the bill.
