A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to soil and water conservation courses of study
- 2 at community colleges and Iowa state university of science
- 3 and technology.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 266.2, Code 2023, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 266.2 Courses of study.
- 4 1. There shall be adopted and taught at said university of
- 5 science and technology practical courses of study, embracing
- 6 in their leading branches such as relate to agriculture and
- 7 mechanic arts, mines and mining, and ceramics, and such other
- 8 branches as are best calculated to educate thoroughly the
- 9 agricultural and industrial classes in the several pursuits
- 10 and professions of life, including military tactics. If a
- 11 practitioner preparation program as defined in section 272.1
- 12 is established, it shall include the subject of physical
- 13 education.
- 2. The university shall offer a course of study that will
- 15 allow students to obtain an undergraduate degree with a major
- 16 in soil and water conservation.
- 17 Sec. 2. IOWA STATE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY —
- 18 IMPLEMENTATION OF SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DEGREE. IOWA
- 19 state university of science and technology shall offer a course
- 20 of study that complies with section 266.2, subsection 2, no
- 21 later than the fall semester of 2024.
- 22 Sec. 3. STATE BOARD OF REGENTS SOIL AND WATER
- 23 CONSERVATION ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS. The state board of
- 24 regents shall revise its statewide articulation agreement with
- 25 community colleges pursuant to section 262.9, subsection 32,
- 26 to provide for the seamless transfer of general education and
- 27 entry-level agronomy and water quality coursework that will
- 28 count toward the completion of an undergraduate degree with a
- 29 major in soil and water conservation at Iowa state university
- 30 of science and technology.
- 31 EXPLANATION
- 32 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 33 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 34 This bill relates to soil and water conservation courses
- 35 of study at community colleges and Iowa state university of

- 1 science and technology (ISU).
- 2 The bill requires ISU to offer, at a minimum, courses of
- 3 study that will allow students to obtain an undergraduate
- 4 degree with a major in soil and water conservation. The bill
- 5 directs ISU to offer such a course of study no later than the
- 6 fall semester of 2024.
- 7 The bill directs the state board of regents to revise its
- 8 statewide articulation agreement with community colleges to
- 9 provide for the seamless transfer of general education and
- 10 entry-level agronomy and water quality coursework that will
- 11 count toward the completion of an undergraduate degree with a
- 12 major in soil and water conservation at ISU.
