- 1 An Act relating to the hunting of black bears, and making
- penalties applicable.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 481A.1, subsection 21, Code 2023, is
- 2 amended by adding the following new paragraph:
- 3 <u>NEW PARAGRAPH</u>. *i*. Ursus americanus, the American black 4 bear.
- 5 Sec. 2. Section 481A.48, subsection 1, Code 2023, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- A person, except as otherwise provided by law, shall
- 8 not willfully disturb, pursue, shoot, kill, take or attempt
- 9 to take, or have in possession any of the following game
- 10 birds or animals except within the open season established
- 11 by the commission: gray or fox squirrel, bobwhite quail,
- 12 cottontail or jackrabbit, duck, snipe, pheasant, goose,
- 13 woodcock, partridge, mourning dove, coot, rail, ruffed grouse,
- 14 wild turkey, pigeon, black bear, or deer. The seasons, bag
- 15 limits, possession limits, and locality shall be established by
- 16 the department or commission under the authority of sections
- 17 456A.24, 481A.38, and 481A.39.
- 18 Sec. 3. Section 481A.130, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code
- 19 2023, is amended to read as follows:
- 20 a. For each black bear, elk, antelope, buffalo, or moose,
- 21 two thousand five hundred dollars.
- 22 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 25 This bill relates to the hunting of black bears. The bill
- 26 designates black bears as a game animal. The bill prohibits a
- 27 person from willfully disturbing, pursuing, shooting, killing,
- 28 taking or attempting to take, or having in possession a black
- 29 bear outside of an open season established by the natural
- 30 resource commission. The commission may allow for the hunting
- 31 of black bears subject to limitations the commission imposes.
- 32 A violation of the bill is subject to a scheduled fine
- 33 dependent on the matter of the offense relating to an unlawful
- 34 take or attempt to take. Additionally, a person who is
- 35 convicted of taking a black bear in violation of the bill

H.F. 89

- 1 shall pay civil damages in the amount of \$2,500. A black bear
- 2 taken in violation of the provisions of the bill is subject to
- 3 seizure by the director of the department of natural resources.
