HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 A Joint Resolution proposing an amendment to the Constitution
- 2 of the State of Iowa relating to the right of the people to a
- 3 clean environment.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of 2 the State of Iowa is proposed:

3 Article 1 of the Constitution of the State of Iowa is amended 4 by adding the following new section:

5 Sec. 1B. Right to clean environment. Every person has the 6 right to a clean and healthy environment, including pure water, 7 clean air, a stable climate, ecologically healthy habitats, 8 and the preservation of the natural and human health qualities 9 of the environment. The state shall not infringe upon these 10 rights. The state's public natural resources, including its ll soils, waters, air, flora, fauna, climate, and public lands, 12 are the common property of the people, including both present 13 and future generations. As trustee of these resources, the 14 state shall conserve, maintain, and restore these resources for 15 the health and benefit of all the people. This section and 16 the rights stated herein are self-executing and shall be in 17 addition to any rights conferred by the public trust doctrine 18 or common law. Any and all infringements upon these rights 19 shall be subject to strict scrutiny.

Sec. 2. REFERRAL AND PUBLICATION. The foregoing proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa is referred to the general assembly to be chosen at the next general election for members of the general assembly, and shall be published as provided by law for three months previous to the the date of that election.

The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

This joint resolution proposes an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Iowa providing that every person has a right to a clean and healthy environment, including pure water, clean air, a stable climate, ecologically healthy habitats, and the preservation of the natural and human health qualities of the environment. The state shall not infringe upon these rights. The proposed amendment declares that the

1 state's public natural resources are the common property of 2 the people, including both present and future generations, 3 and that the state, as trustee, shall conserve, maintain, and 4 restore these resources for the health and benefit of all the 5 people. The proposed amendment and the rights stated therein 6 are self-executing and shall be in addition to any rights 7 conferred by the public trust doctrine or common law. The 8 proposed amendment states that any and all infringements upon 9 these rights shall be subject to strict scrutiny.

10 The resolution, if adopted, would be published and then 11 referred to the next general assembly (91st) for adoption a 12 second time, before being submitted to the electorate for 13 ratification.
