HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 103

- 1 A Resolution affirming the powers reserved to the
- 2 states under the Tenth Amendment to the United
- 3 States Constitution.
- 4 WHEREAS, the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution of
- 5 the United States reads as follows: "The powers not
- 6 delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor
- 7 prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the
- 8 States respectively, or to the people."; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the Tenth Amendment defines the total scope
- 10 of federal powers as being that specifically granted by
- 11 the United States Constitution and no more; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the scope of federal power defined by the
- 13 Tenth Amendment means that the federal government was
- 14 created by the states specifically to be an agent of
- 15 the states; and
- 16 WHEREAS, state authority has been eroded primarily
- 17 by federal assumption of powers reserved to the states,
- 18 interpretations of the Commerce Clause of the United
- 19 States Constitution that go beyond any reasonable
- 20 conception, threats of withholding, withdrawing, or
- 21 diverting federal funds, and failure by the states to
- 22 challenge federal intrusions; and
- 23 WHEREAS, currently, the states are demonstrably
- 24 treated as agents of the federal government; and
- 25 WHEREAS, numerous resolutions have been forwarded
- 26 to the federal government without any response or
- 27 result from the United States Congress or the federal
- 28 government; and

- 1 WHEREAS, many federal mandates are directly in
- 2 violation of the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution
- 3 of the United States; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the United States Supreme Court has ruled
- 5 that Congress may not commandeer the legislative and
- 6 regulatory processes of the states; and
- 7 WHEREAS, a number of proposals from previous
- 8 administrations and some now pending from the present
- 9 administration and from the United States Congress may
- 10 further violate the United States Constitution; NOW
- 11 THEREFORE,
- 12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, That
- 13 the House of Representatives hereby claims sovereignty
- 14 under the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution of the
- 15 United States over all powers not otherwise enumerated
- 16 and granted to the federal government by the United
- 17 States Constitution; and
- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the House of
- 19 Representatives demands the federal government
- 20 immediately cease and desist all mandates that are
- 21 beyond the scope of its constitutionally delegated
- 22 powers; and
- 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the House of
- 24 Representatives encourages each state to reaffirm its
- 25 sovereignty and serve notice to the federal government
- 26 to cease and desist all activity outside the scope of
- 27 its constitutional powers; and
- 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this
- 29 resolution be sent to the President of the United
- 30 States, the President of the United States Senate, the

- 1 Speaker of the United States House of Representatives,
- 2 the Speaker of the House and the President of the
- 3 Senate of each state's legislature, and the members of
- 4 Iowa's congressional delegation.
