- 1 Section 1. Section 257.11B, subsection 11, paragraph a, as
- 2 enacted by 2023 Iowa Acts, House File 68, section 7, is amended
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 a. Each pupil participating in the education savings
- 5 account program is required to take all applicable state and
- 6 federally required student assessments and shall have the
- 7 option to take all state-required assessments, and the results
- 8 of those assessments shall be provided to the pupil's parents
- 9 or guardians and reported to the department of education.
- 10 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 11 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 12 Sec. 3. RETROACTIVE APPLICABILITY. This Act applies
- 13 retroactively to January 24, 2023.
- 14 EXPLANATION
- 15 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 17 This bill relates to assessments required to be administered
- 18 to students participating in the education savings account
- 19 program.
- 20 2023 Iowa Acts, House File 68, establishes an education
- 21 savings account program for school budget years beginning on or
- 22 after July 1, 2023, for the payment of qualified educational
- 23 expenses incurred by the parent or guardian of an eligible
- 24 pupil enrolled in a nonpublic school. Under the program,
- 25 pupils are required to take all applicable state and federally
- 26 required student assessments. The bill strikes the provision
- 27 requiring such pupils to take student assessments required by
- 28 the state. The bill takes effect upon enactment and applies
- 29 retroactively to January 24, 2023.
