A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act establishing a dairy innovation fund and program to be
- 2 administered by the economic development authority.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **15E.371 Dairy innovation fund and** 2 program.
- 3 l. As used in this section unless the context otherwise 4 requires:
- 5 a. "Financial assistance" means assistance provided only
- 6 from the moneys and assets legally available to the authority
- 7 pursuant to this section and includes assistance in the form of
- 8 grants, low-interest loans, and forgivable loans.
- 9 b. "Fund" means the dairy innovation fund.
- 10 c. "Located in" means the place or places at which
- 11 a business's operations are located and where at least
- 12 ninety-eight percent of the business's employees work, or where
- 13 employees that are paid at least ninety-eight percent of the
- 14 business's payroll work.
- 15 d. "Program" means the dairy innovation program.
- 16 2. a. The fund is created in the state treasury under
- 17 the control of the authority and consists of any moneys
- 18 appropriated to the fund by the general assembly and any
- 19 other moneys available to or obtained or accepted by the
- 20 authority for placement in the fund. Moneys in the fund are
- 21 appropriated to the authority to award financial assistance as
- 22 provided under the program. The authority shall use any moneys
- 23 specifically appropriated for purposes of this section only for
- 24 the purposes of the program.
- 25 b. Notwithstanding section 8.33, moneys in the fund
- 26 that remain unencumbered or unobligated at the close of the
- 27 fiscal year shall not revert but shall remain available for
- 28 expenditure for the purposes designated until the close of the
- 29 succeeding fiscal year.
- 30 3. The authority shall establish and administer the program
- 31 for the purpose of awarding financial assistance to eligible
- 32 businesses engaged in projects that do all of the following:
- 33 a. Expand or refurbish existing milk plants or establish a
- 34 new milk plant, operating pursuant to a permit issued pursuant
- 35 to section 192.111.

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- 1 b. Expand or refurbish existing mobile dairy processing
- 2 units, or establish new mobile dairy processing units.
- 3 c. Rent building, refrigeration facilities, freezer
- 4 facilities, or equipment necessary to expand dairy processing
- 5 capacity, including mobile dairy or refrigeration units used
- 6 exclusively for dairy processing.
- 7 d. Incorporate methods and technologies that reduce farm
- 8 labor associated with milk production and storage, including
- 9 but not limited to the use of robotics and processes or systems
- 10 that operate using computerized equipment or machinery.
- 11 4. The authority shall establish eligibility criteria for
- 12 the program by rule. The eligibility criteria must include all
- 13 of the following:
- 14 a. The business must be located in this state.
- 15 b. The business must not have been subject to any regulatory
- 16 enforcement action related to federal, state, or local
- 17 environmental, worker safety, food processing, or food safety
- 18 laws, rules, or regulations within the last five years.
- 19 c. The business must only employ individuals legally
- 20 authorized to work in this state.
- 21 d. The business must not currently be in bankruptcy.
- 22 e. The business must employ less than fifty individuals.
- 23 5. A business seeking financial assistance under this
- 24 section shall make application to the authority in the manner
- 25 prescribed by the authority by rule.
- 26 6. Applications shall be accepted during one or more
- 27 annual application periods to be determined by the authority
- 28 by rule. Upon reviewing and scoring all applications that are
- 29 received during an application period, and subject to funding,
- 30 the authority may award financial assistance to eligible
- 31 businesses. A financial assistance award shall not exceed
- 32 the amount of eligible project costs included in the eligible
- 33 business's application. Priority shall be given to eligible
- 34 businesses whose proposed project under subsection 3 will do
- 35 any of the following:

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- 1 a. Create new jobs.
- 2 b. Create or expand opportunities for local small-scale milk
- 3 producers to market pasteurized milk and milk products under
- 4 private labels.
- 5 c. Provide greater flexibility or convenience for local
- 6 small-scale farmers to have milk processed.
- 7 d. Reduce labor associated with the on-farm production and
- 8 storage of milk.
- 9 7. A business that is awarded financial assistance under
- 10 this section may apply for financial assistance under other
- ll programs administered by the authority.
- 12 8. The authority shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter 17A
- 13 to administer this section.
- 14 EXPLANATION
- 15 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 17 This bill establishes a dairy innovation fund (fund) and
- 18 dairy innovation program (program) to be administered by the
- 19 economic development authority (authority).
- 20 The bill creates the fund in the state treasury under
- 21 the control of the authority, which consists of any moneys
- 22 appropriated to the fund by the general assembly and any other
- 23 moneys available to the authority for placement in the fund.
- 24 Moneys in the fund are appropriated to provide financial
- 25 assistance (assistance) as provided under the program.
- 26 "Financial assistance" is defined to include assistance in the
- 27 form of grants, low-interest loans, and forgivable loans.
- 28 The authority must use any moneys specifically appropriated
- 29 to the program only for purposes of supporting the program.
- 30 The appropriated moneys that remain unencumbered or unobligated
- 31 at the close of the fiscal year do not revert but remain
- 32 available for expenditure for the program until the close of
- 33 the succeeding fiscal year.
- 34 The authority must establish and administer the program for
- 35 the purpose of awarding assistance to eligible businesses for

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- 1 projects that expand or refurbish an existing, or establish
- 2 a new, milk plant; expand or refurbish an existing, or
- 3 establish a new, mobile dairy processing unit; rent buildings,
- 4 refrigeration facilities, freezer facilities, or equipment
- 5 necessary to expand processing capacity, including mobile dairy
- 6 or refrigeration units; or incorporate methods and technologies
- 7 that reduce farm labor associated with milk production and
- 8 storage.
- 9 The authority must establish eligibility criteria for the
- 10 program by rule, and the criteria must include the requirements
- ll detailed in the bill. A business seeking assistance under
- 12 the program must make application to the authority in the
- 13 manner prescribed by the authority by rule. Applications must
- 14 be accepted during one or more annual application periods
- 15 determined by the authority by rule. After reviewing and
- 16 scoring all applications received during an application period,
- 17 and subject to funding, the authority may award assistance
- 18 to eligible businesses. A financial assistance award cannot
- 19 exceed the amount of eligible project costs included in an
- 20 eligible business's application. The bill requires that
- 21 priority be given to eligible businesses whose proposed project
- 22 will create new jobs; create or expand opportunities for local
- 23 small-scale milk producers to market pasteurized milk and milk
- 24 products under private labels; provide greater flexibility
- 25 or convenience for local small-scale farmers to have milk
- 26 processed; and reduce labor associated with the on-farm
- 27 production and storage of milk.
- 28 A business that is awarded assistance under the program may
- 29 apply for assistance under other programs administered by the
- 30 authority.
- 31 The authority is required to adopt rules to administer the
- 32 fund and program.
