## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act providing for the transportation of biogas using a
- 2 gathering line system constructed within a secondary road
- 3 right-of-way, and including effective date provisions.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 306.2, Code 2023, is amended by adding
- 2 the following new subsection:
- 3 NEW SUBSECTION. 1A. "Biogas gathering line system" means a
- 4 system of one or more gathering lines as defined in 49 C.F.R.
- 5 §192.3, if each gathering line operates at or under one hundred
- 6 twenty-five per square inch gauge, and is used to transport
- 7 biogas from one or more anaerobic digester systems, as defined
- 8 in section 459.102, to a processing facility for the production
- 9 of renewable natural gas.
- Sec. 2. Section 306.46, Code 2023, is amended to read as
- 11 follows:
- 12 306.46 Public utility Utility facilities public road
- 13 rights-of-way.
- 14 l. a. A public utility may construct, operate, repair,
- 15 or maintain its utility facilities within a public road
- 16 right-of-way. The location of new utility facilities shall
- 17 comply with section 318.9. A utility facility shall not be
- 18 constructed or installed in a manner that causes interference
- 19 with public use of the road.
- 20 2. b. For purposes of this section paragraph "a", "public
- 21 utility" means a public utility as defined in section 476.1, and
- 22 shall also include waterworks, municipally owned waterworks,
- 23 joint water utilities, rural water districts incorporated under
- 24 chapter 357A or chapter 504, cooperative water associations,
- 25 and electric transmission owners as defined in section 476.27
- 26 primarily providing service to public utilities as defined in
- 27 section 476.1. For the purposes of this section paragraph
- 28 "a", "utility facilities" means any cables, conduits, wire,
- 29 pipe, casing pipe, supporting poles, guys, and other material
- 30 and equipment utilized for the furnishing of electric, gas,
- 31 communications, water, or sewer service.
- A person owning, operating, or controlling an anaerobic
- 33 digester system or a person owning, operating, or controlling a
- 34 processing facility for the production of renewable natural gas
- 35 may construct, operate, repair, or maintain a biogas gathering

- 1 line system within a secondary road right-of-way. A gathering
- 2 line system shall not be constructed or installed in a manner
- 3 that, by its use, causes interference with public use of the
- 4 road.
- 5 3. This section shall not impair or interfere with a city's
- 6 authority to grant, amend, extend, or renew a franchise as
- 7 provided in section 364.2, and shall not impair or interfere
- 8 with a city's existing general police powers to control the use
- 9 of its right-of-way.
- 10 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act, being deemed of immediate
- 11 importance, takes effect upon enactment.
- 12 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- This bill amends provisions that allow a public utility to
- 16 construct, operate, and maintain a public utility facility
- 17 within a public road right-of-way so long as the facility
- 18 does not cause interference with the road's use (amended
- 19 Code section 306.46). The bill provides the same right to
- 20 a person who constructs, operates, and maintains one or more
- 21 gathering lines located within a secondary road right-of-way
- 22 that transport biogas from an anaerobic digester system
- 23 to a processing facility for the production of renewable
- 24 natural gas. An anaerobic digester system is connected to a
- 25 confinement feeding operation housing livestock that stores
- 26 liquid manure on site using a storage structure (Code section
- 27 459.206). An anaerobic digester processes liquid manure
- 28 by utilizing bacteria to break down organic matter in the
- 29 absence of oxygen for purposes of producing, collecting, and
- 30 transporting biogas (Code section 459.102). Generally, a
- 31 gathering line is a type of pipeline used to move gas from
- 32 its point of production to another facility for processing
- 33 (refinement).
- 34 The bill takes effect upon enactment.
