A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the licensure of medical cannabidiol
- 2 dispensaries.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 124E.8, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code
2 2023, is amended to read as follows:

a. The department shall issue a request for proposals accept
<u>applications</u> to select and license by April 1, 2018, up to
<u>five ten</u> medical cannabidiol dispensaries to dispense medical
cannabidiol within this state consistent with the provisions
of this chapter. The department shall license new medical
cannabidiol dispensaries or relicense the existing medical
cannabidiol dispensaries by December 1 of each year.

10 Sec. 2. Section 124E.8, subsection 2, Code 2023, is amended 11 by striking the subsection.

12 Sec. 3. Section 124E.8, Code 2023, is amended by adding the 13 following new subsection:

14 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 3A. The department shall not issue more 15 than one license for a medical cannabidiol dispensary per 16 county.

17 Sec. 4. Section 124E.9, subsection 1, Code 2023, is amended 18 to read as follows:

1. a. The medical cannabidiol dispensaries shall be located
 20 based on geographical need throughout the state to improve
 21 patient access.

22 b. A medical cannabidiol dispensary may dispense medical 23 cannabidiol pursuant to the provisions of this chapter but 24 shall not dispense any medical cannabidiol in a form or 25 quantity other than the form or quantity allowed by the 26 department pursuant to rule.

27 Sec. 5. MEDICAL CANNABIDIOL DISPENSARY LICENSES — CURRENT 28 LICENSEES.

29 1. The department of health and human services shall accept 30 applications for new medical cannabidiol dispensary licenses 31 from current licensees between July 1, 2023, and October 1, 32 2023.

Notwithstanding section 124E.8, subsection 3, in
evaluating an application pursuant to this section, the
department shall consider only the security, physical layout,

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2 3. A licensee submitting an application pursuant to
3 this section may hold a maximum of four medical cannabidiol
4 dispensary licenses, including the licensee's current license.
5 EXPLANATION

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The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

8 This bill relates to the licensure of medical cannabidiol 9 dispensaries.

10 The bill increases the maximum number of medical cannabidiol 11 dispensary licenses in the state from 5 to 10. The bill 12 prohibits the department of health and human services from 13 issuing more than one medical cannabidiol dispensary license 14 per county. The bill strikes a provision requiring the 15 department to locate medical cannabidiol dispensaries based on 16 geographical need throughout the state.

17 The bill requires the department of health and human 18 services to accept applications for medical cannabidiol 19 dispensary licenses from current licensees between July 1, 20 2023, and October 1, 2023. In evaluating an application from 21 a current licensee, the department shall consider only the 22 security, physical layout, and plan for technology at the 23 proposed location. A licensee may hold a maximum of four 24 medical cannabidiol dispensary licenses.

The bill strikes a provision in current law requiring a medical cannabidiol dispensary to agree to begin supplying medical cannabidiol by December 1, 2018.

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
