- 1 Section 1. Section 43.91, Code 2023, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 43.91 Voter at caucus qualifications.
- 4 Any person voting at a precinct caucus must be a person who
- 5 is or will by the date of the next general election become
- 6 an eligible elector, who has not already participated in the
- 7 caucus of any political party within the same year, who has
- 8 been a member of the political party holding the precinct
- 9 caucus for seventy days immediately preceding the precinct
- 10 caucus, who is physically present at the location of the
- ll precinct caucus, and who is a resident of the precinct. A list
- 12 of the names and addresses of each person to whom a ballot was
- 13 delivered or who was allowed to vote in each precinct caucus
- 14 shall be prepared by the caucus chairperson and secretary who
- 15 shall certify such list to the commissioner at the same time
- 16 as the names of those elected as delegates and party committee
- 17 members are so certified.

- 2 physically present at the location of the precinct caucus.
- 3 The bill strikes a requirement that the state registrar
- 4 of voters use information from the electronic registration
- 5 information center to update information in the statewide
- 6 voter registration system, including a report of voters that
- 7 are eligible but unregistered. The bill allows the state
- 8 registrar of voters to use information from other entities to
- 9 update information in the statewide voter registration system,
- 10 including but not limited to reports related to certain subject
- 11 areas set forth under current law.
