A BILL FOR

1 An Act authorizing certain persons to administer the final

- 2 field test of an approved driver education course.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 321.178, subsection 1, paragraph c, Code 2 2023, is amended to read as follows:

c. Every public school district in Iowa shall offer 3 4 or make available to all students residing in the school 5 district, or Iowa students attending a nonpublic school or 6 receiving competent private instruction or independent private 7 instruction as defined in section 299A.1, in the district, an 8 approved course in driver education. The receiving district 9 shall be the school district responsible for making driver 10 education available to a student participating in open 11 enrollment under section 282.18. The courses may be offered 12 at sites other than at the public school, including nonpublic 13 school facilities within the public school districts. An 14 approved course offered during the summer months, on Saturdays, 15 after regular school hours during the regular terms or partly 16 in one term or summer vacation period and partly in the 17 succeeding term or summer vacation period, as the case may 18 be, shall satisfy the requirements of this section to the 19 same extent as an approved course offered during the regular 20 school hours of the school term. A student who successfully 21 completes and obtains certification in an approved course 22 in driver education or an approved course in motorcycle 23 education may, upon proof of such fact, be excused from any 24 field test which the student would otherwise be required to 25 take in demonstrating the student's ability to operate a motor 26 vehicle. A student shall not be excused from any field test 27 if a parent, guardian, or instructor requests that a test 28 be administered. A final field test prior to a student's 29 completion of an approved course shall be administered by a 30 person qualified as a classroom driver education instructor and 31 certified to provide street and or highway driving instruction 32 under paragraph "b'', subparagraph (2). A person qualified as 33 a classroom driver education instructor but not certified to 34 provide street and highway driving instruction may administer 35 the final field test if accompanied by another person qualified

1	to provide street and highway driving instruction.
2	EXPLANATION
3	The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
4	the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
5	Under current law, a student driver can complete an approved
6	driver education course which consists of both classroom
7	instruction and street or highway driving instruction. Prior
8	to completion of the course, a final field test must be
9	administered by a person qualified as a classroom driver
10	education instructor and certified to provide street and
11	highway driving instruction.

To be qualified as a classroom driver education instructor, Code section 321.178 requires a person to have satisfied the educational requirements for a teaching license at the selementary or secondary level and hold a valid license to teach driver education in Iowa public schools. To be qualified to provide street or highway driving instruction, a person must be scrtified by the department of transportation and authorized by the board of educational examiners. However, if the person is a peace officer with five or more years of experience, or a retired peace officer who holds a driver's license that required to be authorized by the board of educational examiners. How by the board of screw that two years from the date of issuance, the person is not required to be authorized by the board of educational examiners.

This bill strikes the provisions relating to who may administer a final field test and authorizes a person who is qualified to provide street or highway driving instruction under current law to administer a final field test.
