- 1 An Act relating to the issuance of temporary event alcohol
- 2 licenses, and providing fees.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. <u>NEW SECTION</u>. 123.150 Temporary event alcohol
- 2 license fees.
- Upon application to the department, the director
- 4 may issue a temporary event alcohol license to any of the
- 5 following:
- 6 a. A licensee holding a retail alcohol license pursuant to
- 7 section 123.30.
- 8 b. A permittee holding a beer permit pursuant to section
- 9 123.127.
- 10 c. A permittee holding a wine permit pursuant to section
- 11 123.175.
- 12 2. A temporary event alcohol license permits a licensee
- 13 or permittee to sell alcoholic beverages, for which they are
- 14 otherwise licensed or permitted, at a temporary event location
- 15 for on-premises consumption. A temporary event location is
- 16 a location, other than the licensee's or permittee's primary
- 17 place of business, of an event that will take place for a
- 18 limited period of time, including but not limited to the
- 19 location of a farmers market, festival, tradeshow, or concert.
- 3. A temporary event alcohol license is valid for thirty-six
- 21 consecutive hours.
- 22 4. The fee for a temporary event alcohol license issued
- 23 pursuant to this section is fifty dollars.
- 24 5. The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
- 25 17A to administer this section, including by prescribing
- 26 application requirements.
- 27 EXPLANATION
- 28 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 29 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 30 This bill creates a temporary event alcohol license and
- 31 associated fees. The director of revenue may issue a temporary
- 32 event alcohol license to a licensee holding a retail alcohol
- 33 license, a permittee holding a beer permit, or a permittee
- 34 holding a wine permit, to allow the licensee or permittee to
- 35 sell alcoholic beverages at a temporary event location for

- 1 on-premises consumption. A temporary event location is a
- 2 location of an event that will take place for a limited period
- 3 of time, including a farmers market, festival, tradeshow, or
- 4 concert. A temporary event alcohol license is valid for 36
- 5 consecutive hours, and the fee for a temporary event alcohol
- 6 license is \$50. Fees collected under Code chapter 123 are
- 7 deposited in the beer and liquor control fund.
- 8 The bill authorizes the department of revenue to adopt rules
- 9 to administer the bill, including by prescribing application
- 10 requirements.
