A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act modifying the earliest possible start date of the school
- 2 calendar for school districts and accredited nonpublic
- 3 schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 279.10, subsection 1, Code 2024, is
2 amended to read as follows:

1. The school year for each school district and accredited 3 4 nonpublic school shall begin on July 1 and the school calendar 5 shall begin no sooner than August 23 25, but if August 25 6 is a weekday other than Monday, no sooner than the Monday 7 immediately preceding August 25, and no later than the first 8 Monday in December. The school calendar shall include not 9 less than one hundred eighty days or one thousand eighty hours 10 of instruction during the calendar year, of which not more 11 than five days or thirty hours of instruction may be delivered 12 primarily over the internet except as otherwise provided in 13 section 256.43 or in rules adopted by the state board of 14 education pursuant to section 256.7, subsection 32. The board 15 of directors of a school district and the authorities in 16 charge of an accredited nonpublic school shall determine the 17 school start date for the school calendar in accordance with 18 this subsection and shall set the number of days or hours of 19 required attendance for the school year as provided in section 20 299.1, subsection 2, but the board of directors of a school 21 district shall hold a public hearing on any proposed school 22 calendar prior to adopting the school calendar. If the board 23 of directors of a district or the authorities in charge of an 24 accredited nonpublic school extends the school calendar because 25 inclement weather caused the school district or accredited 26 nonpublic school to temporarily close during the regular school 27 calendar, the school district or accredited nonpublic school 28 may excuse a graduating senior who has met district or school 29 requirements for graduation from attendance during the extended 30 school calendar. A school corporation may begin employment 31 of personnel for in-service training and development purposes 32 before the date to begin elementary and secondary school. 33 EXPLANATION

1 This bill modifies the earliest possible start date of the 2 school calendar for school districts and accredited nonpublic 3 schools. Current law provides that the school calendar for 4 school districts and accredited nonpublic schools shall begin 5 no sooner than August 23. The bill modifies this provision 6 to provide that the school calendar shall, instead, begin no 7 sooner than August 25, but if August 25 is a weekday other than 8 Monday, no sooner than the Monday immediately preceding August 9 25.
