House Study Bill 604 - Introduced

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A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to patriotic exercises and civic and historical
- 2 instruction regarding certain holidays in public schools.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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- 1 Section 1. Section 256.11, subsections 3 and 4, Code 2024,
- 2 are amended to read as follows:
- 3 3. a. The following areas shall be taught in grades
- 4 one through six: English-language arts, social studies,
- 5 mathematics, science, health, physical education, traffic
- 6 safety, music, visual art, and, subject to section 279.80,
- 7 age-appropriate and research-based human growth and
- 8 development. Computer science instruction incorporating
- 9 the standards established under section 256.7, subsection
- 10 26, paragraph "a", subparagraph (4), shall be offered in
- 11 at least one grade level commencing with the school year
- 12 beginning July 1, 2023. The health curriculum shall include
- 13 the characteristics of communicable diseases. The state board
- 14 as part of accreditation standards shall adopt curriculum
- 15 definitions for implementing the elementary program.
- 16 b. (1) The social studies curriculum shall include
- 17 appropriate patriotic exercises and relevant civic and
- 18 historical instruction that conveys to students the meaning and
- 19 significance of all of the following days:
- 20 (a) Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. 's birthday.
- 21 (b) Abraham Lincoln's birthday.
- 22 (c) George Washington's birthday.
- 23 (d) Armed Forces Day.
- 24 (e) Memorial Day.
- 25 (f) Constitution Day.
- 26 (g) Columbus Day.
- 27 (h) Veterans Day.
- 28 (i) Thanksgiving Day.
- 29 (j) Bill of Rights Day.
- 30 (2) The patriotic exercises and relevant civic and
- 31 historical instruction described in subparagraph (1) shall take
- 32 place on the day of the holiday, or if that day is not a school
- 33 day, then the immediately preceding or following school day or
- 34 week.
- 35 c. Paragraph "b" shall not apply to a nonpublic school.

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      4. a. The following shall be taught in grades seven and
 2 eight: English-language arts; social studies; mathematics;
 3 science; health; age-appropriate and research-based human
 4 growth and development; career exploration and development;
 5 physical education; music; and visual art. Computer science
 6 instruction incorporating the standards established under
 7 section 256.7, subsection 26, paragraph "a", subparagraph (4),
 8 shall be offered in at least one grade level commencing with
 9 the school year beginning July 1, 2023. Career exploration
10 and development shall be designed so that students are
11 appropriately prepared to create an individual career
12 and academic plan pursuant to section 279.61, incorporate
13 foundational career and technical education concepts aligned
14 with the six career and technical education service areas as
15 defined in subsection 5, paragraph "h", incorporate relevant
16 twenty-first century skills to facilitate career readiness,
17 and introduce students to career opportunities within the
18 local community and across this state. The health curriculum
19 shall include age-appropriate and research-based information
20 regarding the characteristics of sexually transmitted diseases.
21 The state board as part of accreditation standards shall adopt
22 curriculum definitions for implementing the program in grades
23 seven and eight. However, this subsection shall not apply to
24 the teaching of career exploration and development in nonpublic
25 schools.
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- 26 b. (1) The social studies curriculum shall include
- 27 appropriate patriotic exercises and relevant civic and
- 28 historical instruction that conveys to students the meaning and
- 29 significance of all of the following days:
- 30 (a) Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday.
- 31 (b) Abraham Lincoln's birthday.

- 5 (2) The patriotic exercises and relevant civic and
- 6 historical instruction described in subparagraph (1) shall take
- 7 place on the day of the holiday, or if that day is not a school

- 10 c. Paragraph "b" shall not apply to a nonpublic school.
- 11 Sec. 2. Section 256.11, subsection 5, paragraph b, Code
- 12 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 13 b. Five units of the social studies including instruction
- 14 in voting statutes and procedures, voter registration
- 15 requirements, the use of paper ballots and voting systems in
- 16 the election process, and the method of acquiring and casting
- 17 an absentee ballot. All students shall complete a minimum
- 18 of one-half unit of United States government and one unit of
- 19 United States history.
- 20 (1) The one-half unit of United States government shall
- 21 include the voting procedure as described in this lettered
- 22 paragraph and section 280.9A. The government instruction shall
- 23 also include a study of the Constitution of the United States
- 24 and the Bill of Rights contained in the Constitution and an
- 25 assessment of a student's knowledge of the Constitution and the
- 26 Bill of Rights.
- 27 (2) (a) The one unit of United States history shall
- 28 include appropriate patriotic exercises and relevant civic and
- 29 historical instruction that conveys to students the meaning and
- 30 significance of all of the following days:
- 31 (i) Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. 's birthday.
- 32 (ii) Abraham Lincoln's birthday.
- 33 (iii) George Washington's birthday.
- 34 (iv) Armed Forces Day.
- 35 (v) Memorial Day.

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- 1 (vi) Constitution Day.
- 2 (vii) Columbus Day.
- 3 (viii) Veterans Day.
- 4 (ix) Thanksgiving Day.
- 5 (x) Bill of Rights Day.
- 6 (b) The patriotic exercises and relevant civic and
- 7 historical instruction described in subparagraph division (a)
- 8 shall take place on the day of the holiday, or if that day is
- 9 not a school day, then the immediately preceding or following
- 10 school day or week.
- 11 (3) Subparagraph (2) shall not apply to a nonpublic school.
- 12 Sec. 3. Section 256E.7, subsection 2, paragraph q, Code
- 13 2024, is amended to read as follows:
- 14 g. Be subject to and comply with the requirements of section
- 15 256.7, subsection 21, and the educational standards of section
- 16 256.11, unless specifically waived by the state board during
- 17 the application process; provided, however, that the state
- 18 board shall not waive the educational standards related to
- 19 social studies instruction established in section 256.11,
- 20 subsections 3 and 4, and in section 256.11, subsection 5,
- 21 paragraph "b".
- Sec. 4. Section 256F.4, subsection 2, Code 2024, is amended
- 23 by adding the following new paragraph:
- 24 NEW PARAGRAPH. p. Be subject to and comply with the
- 25 requirements of section 256.11, subsections 3 and 4, and
- 26 section 256.11, subsection 5, paragraph "b", relating to
- 27 educational standards related to social studies instruction in
- 28 the same manner as a school district.
- 29 Sec. 5. IMPLEMENTATION OF ACT. Section 25B.2, subsection
- 30 3, shall not apply to this Act.
- 31 EXPLANATION
- 32 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with
- 33 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 34 This bill relates to patriotic exercises and civic and
- 35 historical instruction regarding certain holidays in public

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1 schools.

- 2 The bill provides that the social studies curriculum
- 3 provided to students enrolled in grades 1 through 12 in school
- 4 districts, charter schools, and innovation zone schools shall
- 5 include appropriate patriotic exercises and relevant civic and
- 6 historical instruction that conveys to students the meaning
- 7 and significance of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday,
- 8 Abraham Lincoln's birthday, George Washington's birthday, Armed
- 9 Forces Day, Memorial Day, Constitution Day, Columbus Day,
- 10 Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Bill of Rights Day. The
- 11 bill establishes that the patriotic exercises and relevant
- 12 civic and historical instruction shall take place on the day
- 13 of the holiday, or if that day is not a school day, then the
- 14 immediately preceding or following school day or week.
- The bill may include a state mandate as defined in Code
- 16 section 25B.3. The bill makes inapplicable Code section
- 17 25B.2, subsection 3, which would relieve a school district
- 18 from complying with a state mandate if funding for the cost of
- 19 the state mandate is not provided or specified. Therefore,
- 20 school districts are required to comply with any state mandate
- 21 included in the bill.
