## A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to the ability of peace officers to file
- 2 a petition for emergency protective orders on behalf of
- 3 persons seeking relief from domestic abuse.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 236.6, Code 2024, is amended by adding 2 the following new subsection:

3 <u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 1A. A peace officer may file a petition 4 under subsection 1 on behalf of a person if that person claims 5 to be in present danger of domestic abuse and the person 6 requests the peace officer to submit the petition.

EXPLANATION

8 The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with 9 the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.

10 This bill allows a peace officer to file a petition to 11 receive a 72-hour emergency protective order on a person's 12 behalf if the person claims to be in present danger of domestic 13 abuse and the person requests the peace officer to submit the 14 petition.
